

DELIVERY AND GOODS SENT 'ON APPROVAL' BOOST COSTS HIGHER

Chamber of Commerce Head and Merchant Points Out Where Expense Falls.

University of Washington, April 30.—The delivery of goods and the taking of goods upon approval are responsible for an unnecessary part of the high cost of living, according to A. J. Rhodes of the Rhodes department store of Seattle, who spoke before the recent housekeepers' convention on "The Ethics of Shopping."

Thirty per cent of all goods sold must be delivered, according to Mr. Rhodes. The other 70 per cent of the purchasers have to stand the cost of the delivery in their proportionate share, he says.
