Weather Conditions

The barometric pressure is still high in the extreme northeastern and extreme southwestern portions of the interior. Pressure is below normal in the interior, more especially in the western states with centers of depression occupying the same relative positions as they did 24 hours ago, viz., Arizona, central California and the southern portions of the Pacific coast. The storm clouds are still in the northeast, but generally clear skies prevail throughout the remainder of the country. Temperatures fell slightly in the northwest, the extreme southeast, and in the region of the great lakes, where they were somewhat lower. Showers were reported in the lower plains and in Montana. It was fairly elsewhere.

The conditions are favorable for fair weather in this vicinity tonight and Sunday.

Train to Sawmill of East-

tern & Western Company.
