Food Preserving Methods

Directions Presented Here Are Supplied by the Government Bulletins From the Department of Agriculture and by the Experts of the Oregon Agricultural college at Corvallis.

ARTICLE 19—CANNING GREEN PEAS AND SNAP BEANS.
Housekeepers can easily can surplus green peas and snap beans, which are beginning to appear in home gardens in many sections.

Put the prepared vegetables in a cheesecloth bag or colander and wash in cold water for 10 minutes.

Next dip the blanched product quickly in cold water and remove it almost immediately.

Fill the containers completely with boiling hot water which has been added one level teaspoonful of salt per quart.

Wax and string beans as well as young tender peas may be sterilized in 120 minutes.

Remove jars from boiler or sterilizer, tighten covers, invert to cool and test the joints for leakage.
