

OREGON AGGIES BEAT IDAHO TEAM, 26 TO 6, ON PENDLETON FIELD

First Intercollegiate Football
Game in History of East-
ern Oregon.

HEAVY BACKS CRUSH LINE

Newman and Archibald Slip Idaho
Passes Converted Into Touchdown.

Pendleton, Or., Oct. 20.—Playing su-
perior ball except in the first quar-
ter, O. A. C.'s football team, this
afternoon vanquished Coach Bleas-
master's light team of Idaho by a 26
to 6 score in the first inter-collegiate
game ever played in Eastern Oregon.
In the first quarter Idaho appeared
to have a fighting chance, for the
advantage was in her favor. O. A. C.
only made yardage once in this period
to Idaho's four times, and this, with
penalties, kept the ball in Aggie ter-
ritory. In the second period, however,
Pipal's men struck a fast pace and
Captain Newman and Archibald
punched the line repeatedly for big
gains, the latter going over for a
touchdown within minutes and a half
of time. Cole missed goal.

In the second half the Oregon
team's superiority was even more ap-
parent, the Idaho line crumpling under
the heavy backfield battery. After
charging down to the 10 yard line, O.
A. C. was penalized five yards, but
Newman went through on the next
play for a touchdown and Cole kicked
goal.

Reardon Stepped Out
"Butts" Reardon made a touchdown
on a run of 50 yards after receiving
an Idaho punt, but Referee Hinder-
man ruled he stepped out of bounds,
though Coach Pipal maintained he was
three feet from the line. The quarter
ended without further scoring, but on
the second down in the final quarter,
O. A. C. tried its first forward pass.
Hubbard received the ball from New-
man and ran 40 yards for a touch-
down. Cole missed.

The final score for O. A. C. came as
a result of a 35 yard run by Newman
after he had waded through the Idaho
line.

Idaho's score came within a few
minutes of the close of the game.
When Bershear uncorked a forward
pass to Roberts, who carried it 35
yards for a touchdown, Thompson
missed goal.

Thousand Fans See Game
The weather was clear and warm,
the field fast and a crowd of a thou-
sand witnessed the game.

PATRICK WOULD CHANGE HOCKEY RULE FOR SPEED

Would Legalize Kicking of
Puck by Player in Cen-
ter Ice.

Vancouver, B. C., Oct. 20.—At least
one change will be made in the hockey
rules on the coast this season, ac-
cording to announcement by Frank
Patrick, president of the P. C. H. A.,
today. The coast prexy believes that
by legalizing the kicking of the puck
in center ice that it will add speed to
the play and offset the conservatism of
the referee halting a rush when a play-
er happens to block the puck with his
skate.

President Patrick also expects to en-
large the center area, by at least 10
feet. He believes that by increasing the
size of the playing area in center ice
that it will also speed up the game.
The elimination of off-sides in this
area speeded up the play and by en-
larging the space it is believed that
play will be made much faster.

All plans in connection with the or-
ganization of the hockey league will be
discussed at the Seattle gathering on
October 30.

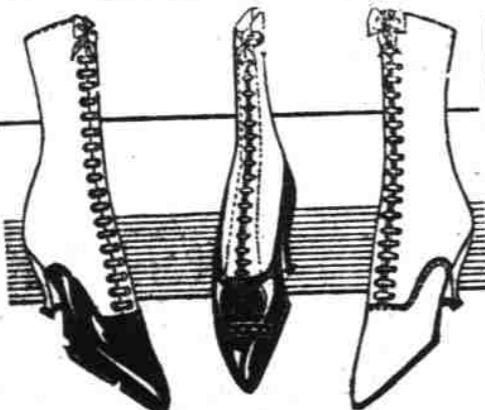

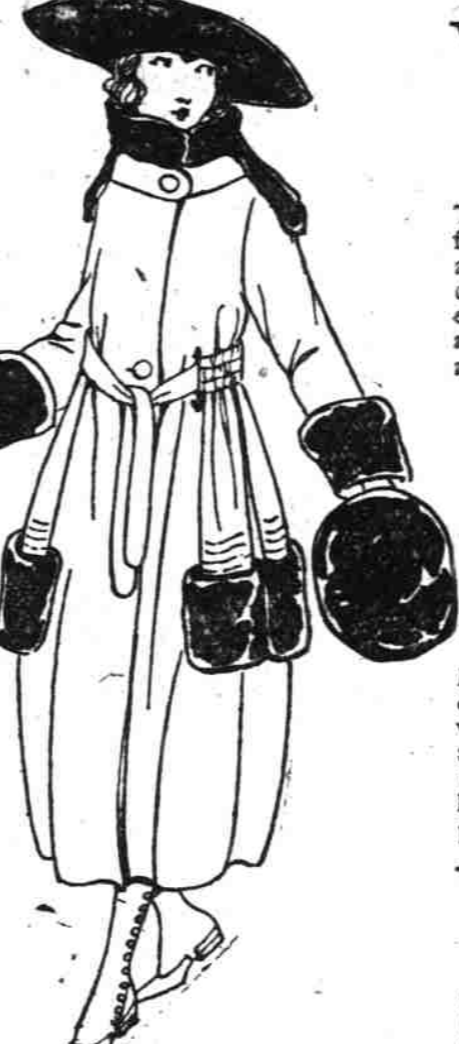
