

KEVIN SMITH, BOY SCOUT, 13, HAS SOLD 200 LIBERTY BONDS

Lad Has Honor of Raising Flag to Top of Bulletin Board at the Postoffice.

TOTAL SALES \$14,000

W. W. Cotton Presides at Ceremonies and Pays Tribute to Work of Boy Scouts in Campaign.

Kenton Smith, American boy. He is just a wee tad. In fact, he has the distinction of being the smallest Boy Scout in Portland. His age is 13.

But that was no handicap to him in serving his country. For he has the record of having sold more Liberty bonds than any of his comrades. During the last five days he sold 200 bonds representing a sum of \$14,000. And by virtue of this service to his country he was given the honor of raising the flag on the Liberty loan bulletin board this noon at the ceremonies under the auspices of the Boy Scouts of Portland.

Kenton is the son of M. L. Smith, of 39 Glen avenue north, and a pupil of Irvington school. He is a member of troop 44, Boy Scouts.

Explaining how he sold so many bonds, Kenton said: "I just ask them to buy and if they said 'No' I just kept on asking them."

In opening the program W. W. Cotton, who presided, said that the Boy Scouts of Portland had sold \$200,000 worth of bonds. Charles P. Berg was the speaker. He made a stirring appeal for subscriptions to the Liberty loan "up to the very last hour," declaring that those who have not purchased bonds are slackers in the cause.

"A bond should be in every American home," was his contention.

A large number of Boy Scouts, headed by Scoutmaster Brockway, were on hand for the event and sang one of their Liberty loan songs.

\$22,000,000 BOND SALES FOR OREGON

The aggregate of subscriptions at noon was \$22,000,000. More than \$2,500,000 in additional subscriptions was reported from the state outside of Portland.

This is the last day of the campaign, but every second of it will be utilized in the effort to reach the total of the \$22,000,000 maximum.

Banks Open Until Midnight

Disregarding the usual Saturday half holiday rule, all banks will be open until a late hour tonight, even to midnight, if necessary, for the selling of bonds, and at headquarters, Fifth and Stark streets, a large number of clerks will be on hand to take last minute subscriptions.

No one is sitting back and watching the results of the campaign come in. The driving is still going on as hard as ever, with the business men, committee men working hard for his subscriptions. These men have laid aside their business for the time being, and are putting everything in the effort to secure the millions extra that will drive Oregon into the honor column with a maximum subscription.

Tonight there will be speakers in the streets in front of the banks of the west side. There will be "bally-hoo" men on Washington street, directing people to the banks, and there will be a large number of men in business streets that will pass the banks and Liberty loan headquarters, in fact everything possible will be done to corner every dollar for the Liberty loan fund in the few hours that are left for the state to make good.

Grand Showing by Powers

The town of Powers, on Coos bay, probably has the largest Liberty loan States now with the amount of its subscriptions. The allotment for Powers was \$5000 and over \$30,000, or 600 per cent of the maximum allotment has been raised, according to the final wire at noon today.

Realizing how acute is the emergency today, many of the larger Portland subscribers have doubled their subscriptions this morning. Paul C. Bates of McCarver, Bates & Lewis, who has the maximum quota, has doubled his subscription to \$5000. Ben Selling subscribed another \$50,000 for bonds this morning.

Two welcome additions to the Oregon total came from the S. P. & S. and the Southern Pacific railway employees, according to an announcement this noon by Emergency Director vice president of the Northwestern National Bank.

Mail Employees Add Big Sum

The S. P. & S. employees subscribed a total of \$52,500. The Southern Pacific people came in with \$171,950, an aggregate of \$224,450 which will go into the banking totals today.

Of this Southern Pacific subscription, \$33,300 is allotted to Portland and \$88,650 to the towns of the Willamette valley, and the coast where the company operates.

Through the efforts of canvassers this morning, additional subscriptions of \$5000 each from George Lawrence Sr., George Lawrence Jr., and W. C. Lawrence were made.

The bankers also continuing their work of securing large subscriptions to the last minute, and it was expected that Portland, by midnight, will have added close to \$4,000,000 to its present total.

State Reports Encouraging

The state returns were coming in very strong. Messages giving new totals were piling up by the dozens, and C. A. Miller, state manager, said he did not believe that anywhere near the absolute total would be given out at headquarters by Sunday morning.

Bernard Daly, the energetic chairman of the Lake county committee, wired this morning the assertion that his district would give a quota today, if necessary, in order to help the state attain its maximum.

C. C. Chapman, director of publicity, wired back that the maximum total was necessary and a short time later

Mr. Daly replied with the assertion that \$250,000 had been subscribed and that \$250,000 would be the total when the campaign ends.

Another encouraging message was from Benton county. Chairman A. J. Johnson wired from Corvallis at noon that Benton county had subscribed \$250,000 or 50 per cent of its maximum allotment of \$500,000. This will be raised by tonight, Mr. Johnson said. He announced that the Oregon Agricultural college faculty members had doubled their subscriptions.

City Funds Invested

Some of the big subscriptions reported through the banks today were: Lewis, \$20,000; William Adams, city treasurer, of city funds, \$40,000; Hall & Co., E. G. Young & Co., and Nellie Gadsby, \$10,000 each; Pacific Export Lumber company, \$20,000; the Central Door & Lumber company, \$5000, and employees of the Eastern & Western Lumber company \$5100.
