

O. A. C. Teachers Seek To Pay Income Tax

Corvallis, Or., Feb. 1.—Tom R. Wilson, Deputy United States revenue collector, who has been in this county for a week past advising the people regarding their income tax blanks, reported that 15 of the Oregon Agricultural college faculty asked if they could not pay income tax. Being employees of the state their salaries are exempt. Wilson said that of more than 400 who came to him for information here, only one proved a genuine taxpayer, and that one a farmer who had made more money from his wheat during the war period than he ever made before.
