

GRANT LANDS ARE TO BE OPENED TO ENTRY ON APRIL 29

Period of Filing Is to Close May 25, According to Information Received.

DATA WILL BE AVAILABLE

Lands to Cost \$2.50 Per Acre; 300,000 Acres Classified as Agricultural.

After having been held from the market by the Oregon & California and Southern Pacific railroads for the past half century, the Oregon & California grant lands in the Roseburg land district...

The period for filing upon the lands has been set by the land office as beginning on April 29 and closing on May 25, and before the first date full information will be available at the Portland office of Mr. McLaughlin...

200,000 Acres Included The lands that will be thrown open to entry at this time reach from the California line to township 32 south, and comprise approximately 200,000 acres of agricultural land...

lain-Ferris reversion act. Agricultural land, under the classification of this act, consists of land upon which not more than 300,000 feet of standing timber is to be found per 40 acres...

Land to Cost \$2.50 Per Acre It will be necessary and it is required by the department that the intending settler enter upon the land which he may desire to enter prior to his filing in the land office...

Homestead Law Governs Other than these restrictions the general terms of the homestead law, as to residence and cultivation, will govern the entries and final proof to be made prior to the issuance of patent.

The land office has prepared plat books of the lands to be included in the present opening, which show the various parcels upon which entry may be made.

Those who are now living on lands included in the Roseburg district and were on December 1, 1913, are given a preference right in filing on 160 acres, or less.
