

FLYERS CLING TO PLANE 80 HOURS BEFORE RESCUED

Escape of Ensign E. A. Stone, U. S. N., R. F., and Ensign Moore, R. N. A. S., Is Narrow.

MEN WERE ON CONVOY DUTY

More Than Three Days Were Spent at Sea by Pair Without Food or Drink.

Washington, May 18.—(J. N. S.)—After having clung to the under side of a seaplane pontoon for 80 hours, without food or drink, Ensign E. A. Stone, U. S. N., R. F., of Norfolk, Va., is alive in London, after having spent five weeks in a hospital. The navy department announced today Stone was on a scouting trip with Ensign Eric Moore of the royal naval aviation service when their plane collapsed and fell into the English channel. The two men clung to the pontoon for more than three days before they were finally rescued by the crew of an English trawler.

2209 Planes Made By Curtiss in Year

Buffalo, N. Y., May 18.—(U. P.)—During the first year of the war up to April 1, the Curtiss airplane and motor corporation manufactured and delivered 2209 airplanes, according to the report of the company made public today. One thousand three hundred and seventy-six were the so-called preliminary training type and 839 were advanced training machines, such as are being used in the airplane post service.
