

OREGON FLEET DISTRICTS
27 PER CENT OF EMERGENCY SHIPS
District Adds 42 Steel and Wooden Vessels, 220,000 Tons, January 1 to May 31.
COOS BAY LAUNCHES FIVE
At Oregon's Rate the 12 Emergency Fleet Districts in U. S. Would Launch 2,640,000.

More than 27 per cent of the total tonnage of steel and wooden ships launched in the United States for the Emergency Fleet Corporation in the five month period between January 1 and May 31 of the present year was the product of Oregon district shipbuilders. This startling figure does not include the tonnage of ships launched on Coos Bay, which are credited to California, nor does it include the several launched since May 31.

clude the several launched since May 31. President Edward N. Hurley of the Emergency Fleet Corporation has officially announced that 608,000 tons of shipping were launched on account with the corporation in the five months mentioned. Oregon's exact share of that achievement is about 220,000 tons, or approximately 27 per cent of the total.

A comparison of the accomplishments of the Oregon district with the total tonnage launched in the United States for the Emergency Fleet Corporation in the five month period between January 1 and May 31 of the present year was the product of Oregon district shipbuilders. This startling figure does not include the tonnage of ships launched on Coos Bay, which are credited to California, nor does it include the several launched since May 31.

How these records were made and at the same time how Oregon is turning out better and more rapidly the vessels that are produced in the United States than any other district and almost any other combination of districts will be shown by the Emergency Fleet officials when they visit Oregon next week in connection with the Oregon district shipbuilders.

Therefore, the state of Oregon has given to the cause of the war from her forests and from her labor power in mills, steel foundries and shipyards, 220,000 tons of shipping since the first of the present year.

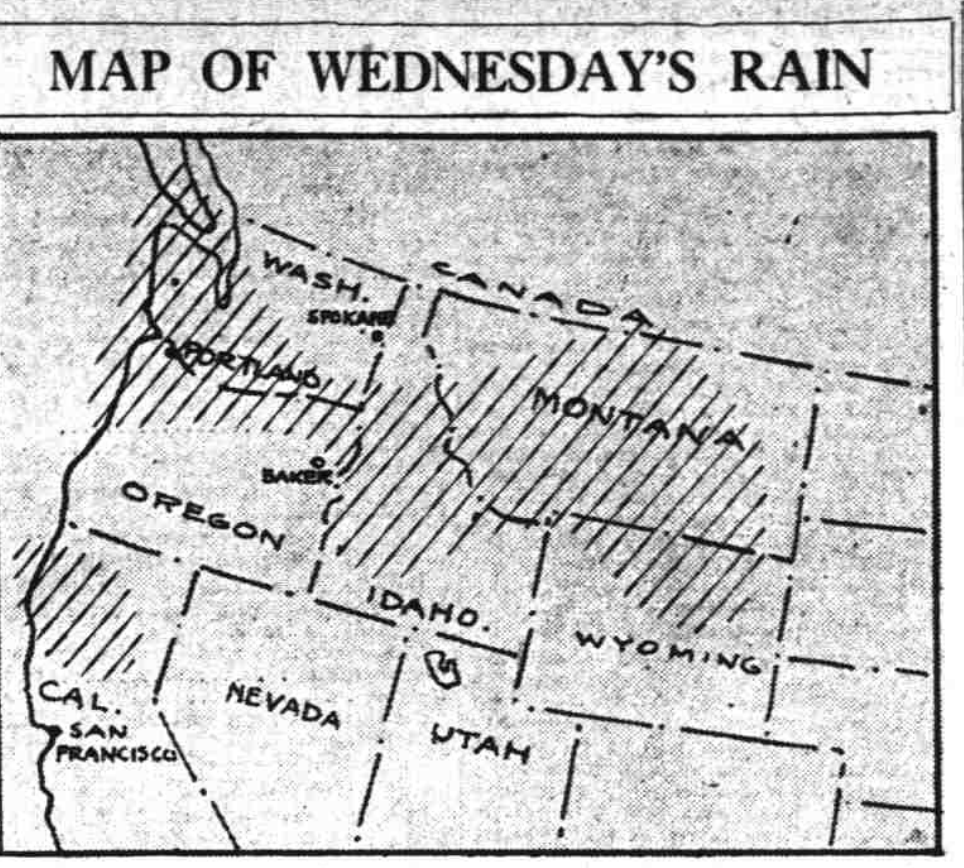
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Bids on a cost plus percentage basis were opened this morning at the regular meeting of the commission of public works and the construction of the St. Johns municipal terminal. Captain John F. Orders from the national service section of the United States Shipping board have recalled the Hon. Crawford Vaughn and Sergeant Major C. H. Smith, who made a few addresses in the Portland district. They left Wednesday night for New York, where the director of their trip, Frank H. Cann, departed today.

The schedule of the party in Portland had been previously cancelled by C. W. Teabolt, local representative of the national service section.

Coos Bay Has Mist Marshfield, June 13.—There was no rain on Coos Bay last night but a heavy fog and mist helped crops to some extent. A rain is badly needed on the farms and the woods are much drier than usual at this time of year.

A light rain would lessen the danger of forest fires, which have done some damage thus far this season. In Curry county there will be heavy crop losses if rain does not come soon.

Berries in Need of Rain Salem, June 13.—No rain fell here Wednesday or last night, but today is cloudy and threatening. Crops are greatly in need of rain. Farmers report that unless they have rain soon the raspberry crop will be practically lost, while loganberries, which have become a big industry in this portion of the valley, are also suffering from lack of moisture. Grain crops are also badly in need of rain.

Pendleton Has Light Rain Pendleton, June 13.—Light rain began about 5 o'clock Wednesday night and continued only a few minutes in most sections, but this moisture means much to grain, farmers who were in town this morning stated. They feel much encouraged for the season, for a normal crop if the weather does not turn extremely hot and steam grain. The rain was of especially big help to spring grain.

Tree Kills Baker Man Baker, Or., June 13.—J. G. Cannon, an aged man employed by the Eastern Oregon Light & Power company, was killed by a tree falling on him yesterday afternoon by a falling tree. Cannon was employed to patrol the pipeline for the company from Olive lake to the powerhouse. The body of the man under the tree had to be extricated with a jack. It is said that Cannon's hearing was impaired and that he probably failed to hear the noise made by the tree when it started to fall.

Clouds at Hood River Hood River, June 13.—Storm clouds passing over this valley during the past 24 hours have failed to fulfill the promise of rain. Precipitation is considerably below normal. However, three irrigation systems which serve the valley have supplied all moisture requirements and all crops, including apples and pears, are in splendid condition.

Showers at Eugene Eugene, June 13.—Slight showers, barely sufficient to lay dust, fell here this morning. Rain is badly needed, as the crops are suffering from the drouth. A severe shortage of forage and grain crops can only be prevented by early and heavy rains.
