

7 CANDIDATES IN SCHOOL DIRECTOR CONTEST SATURDAY
Two to Be Elected; Terms of Dr. Alan Welch Smith and N. G. Pike Soon to Expire.

Voters at the school election of Saturday, next will have seven candidates from which to select two directors to succeed Dr. Alan Welch Smith and N. G. Pike, whose terms of office expire. The seven candidates, who have officially entered the contest and whose names will be on the ballots now being printed, are Mrs. J. F. Chapman, Frank McCrillis, G. E. Hamaker, M. B. McFaul, George M. Orton, William F. Stills and George B. Thomas.

The polls will be open at 12 o'clock noon on Saturday, and will remain open until 8 o'clock in the evening. Any person qualified to vote in a general election, without regard to whether he is a registered voter, will be authorized to cast his ballot at the school election, in the precinct in which he has resided for 30 days prior to the date of the election. There are 69 voting precincts in the school election, into which have been combined the 315 general election precincts of the county which fall within the boundaries of school district 1. 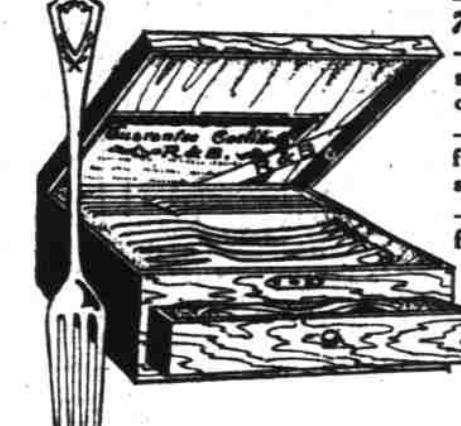
