

DRAFT BOARDS ARE BUSY LISTING MEN FOR SERVICE CALL

Portland Selectives Are Getting Ready to Entrain for Fort McDowell, Cal., on July 5.

RECLASSIFICATION IS BEGUN

Questionnaires Being Sent Out by Local Boards; Men Also Being Picked for Training School

Local draft boards are working day and night this week, preparing the lists of men who are to entrain for Fort McDowell, Cal., July 5, mailing out questionnaires to the new registrants and reclassifying the registrants of last year so as to increase the number of men in class 1.

Mailing of the questionnaires began Monday and will continue through Thursday, 25 per cent being mailed out each day. These questionnaires must be returned to the local boards within seven days from the date of mailing. Every registrant, whether in the service or not, must fill out and return one of the questionnaires. Local advisors for the boards will give free assistance to the registrants in answering the questions.

Reclassification Under Way

The reclassification of last year's registrants is being done by the local boards in conjunction with the appeal board and the advisory boards.

Board members said today that it was impossible to estimate, at present, to what extent the number in class 1 would be increased by the reclassification.

In addition to the selective service men for Fort McDowell, the boards are also announcing the men who are to entrain for San Francisco next Saturday for the special training course at the California school of Mechanical Arts. In some cases these men have volunteered, but the quotas have been partly filled through selection by the local boards.

Embryo Soldiers Study War Science

Eugene, June 27.—But little drill is being done by the men in the summer training camp at the University of Oregon. The major portion of the time is being put on the study of the science of war. It was stated today by Colonel Leader.

The war emergency course in stenography and typewriting at the university summer school opened Monday with 42 enrolled. It is expected that by the last of the week there will be over 50 enrolled. Dean Morton, in charge of the class, announces that he has assurance that the government will hold a civil service examination at the close of the course and that all who take the course will be taken into government service in a very short time.

Irish Colonel Sends Appeal Through T.R.

London, June 27.—(I. N. S.)—Dr. Arthur Lynch, appointed colonel to direct Irish recruiting, is sending an open letter to Colonel Roosevelt, with whom he has been friendly for years, appealing through the colonel for the aid of all Irish Americans against plotting.

Dr. Lynch told the International News Service correspondent today he was certain the Sinn Fein plots were hatched in America, particularly in New York. He will proceed to Dublin Monday.

SWAT THAT FLY WITH POISON; RECIPES ARE NOT HARD TO PREPARE

Various Oils and Flowers Will Have Tendency to Keep the Pests Away.

"Beware of the Dangerous House Fly" is the title to a bulletin issued by the Merchants' association of New York, calling attention to the fact that the fly is more dangerous this year than ever, and that American military records show that it causes more deaths than the enemy.

Kill every fly and burn his body, for each fly killed now means billions less next summer; clean up the premises and insist that neighbors do likewise; do not wait until the insects begin to pest, but anticipate the annoyance—these are some of the pleas made for the elimination of the disease germ carrier.

Poison Recipe Simple
Files in the house, flies in farming and suburban districts, flies in the army camps, all should be immediately eradicated.

The two best poisons for the destruction of flies given out by the United States government consist of formaldehyde and sodium salicylate. Both are superior to arsenic and are not a poison to children. They are convenient to handle, their dilutions are simple and they attract the flies.
