

PORTLAND WILL FIGHT INJUNCTION IN SOUND DISTRICT

Protest Against Proposed Hulls and Boilers Inspection Law Is Sent to Secretary Redfield.

BUSINESS WITH CALIFORNIA Point Is Made That Portland's Interests Are to South of Here and Not to North.

Protesting against the inclusion of the Columbia river in the Puget sound district under the new law providing for the inspection of hulls and boilers, shipping interests would prefer that the law be applied to the Pacific coast districts for the hulls and boiler inspection work here, to attach the Columbia river territory to the California district, rather than to the district of which Puget sound is the center.
