Port of Astoria Bonds—Tuesday afternoon Morris Brothers purchased \$107,000 of 5 per cent bonds of the Port of Astoria and will offer them to the public at a price to net 5 per cent to the investor. The bonds are dated January 1, 1918, and are due \$79,000 on January 1, 1928, and \$28,000 on January 1, 1932.

Potato trade was again firmer and sales on the farmers' market were made as high as \$3.25 per sack during the morning. This was for selected quality of large sized stock, while ordinary stock ruled from \$2.75 and some common stuff at \$2.25 to \$2.50.

Receipts continue very moderate; in fact, scarcely more is coming than is sufficient to fill the trade over from day to day.

Advance of 1c in the price of butter this morning placed the new basis price for extras in plain wrappers at 54c a pound, or 55c for carmen.

This is within a pound of the highest price ever received in the local market, a 56c mark for extras being shown only for one day, Jan. 24, when the market again dropped to 55c a pound.

Country killed hogs advanced to a new high record along Front street when a sale was made during the last 24 hours at 27c a pound.
