Precipitation has occurred in Western Canada and parts of the adjacent states, in the Plains and Gulf states and in the upper Ohio valley. The weather is much cooler in Minnesota and Nebraska. The temperature is nearly normal over most of the country. Fair weather may be expected in Portland and its vicinity tonight and Saturday.

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Through Bills Of Lading Will Still Be Issued

The bureau of foreign and domestic commerce announces that the railroad administration has decided to continue the issuance of through bills of lading via Pacific coast ports after September 30. Announcement was made some time ago by the railroad administration that these bills would be discontinued after September 30, owing to the shortage

of shipping space and resultant congestion of Pacific coast ports.

The railroad administration now reports that conditions have improved and such bills will be issued, under reasonable rules to protect carriers from excessive burdens. It is unofficially stated that these rules will take the form of permits from the United States shipping board guaranteeing ships at the port of embarkation to receive goods. Without such permits railroads will refuse to accept shipments.
