

SUSPECT CLEAN BY OFFICE BELIEVED EASTERN BURGLAR

Man's Shot by Inspector Tackberry While Resisting Arrest; Dies Short Time Later.

MORE INFORMATION SOUGHT Name Believed to Be E. C. Lancaster of Minneapolis, Alias 'M. McRoberts, Alias 'H. Smith.'

While resisting arrest, a man, at present not positively identified but believed to be E. C. Lancaster of Minneapolis, alias 'M. McRoberts, alias 'H. Smith,' was shot at 14 1/2 second street about 4 o'clock Tuesday night by Police Inspector J. M. Tackberry.

Lancaster ran to Alder street and turned east. In front of the Fulton fish market Lancaster stopped as if to take a drink. He was followed by Tackberry and Tackberry fired twice. One shot entered in the back and another under the left arm. The last shot proved fatal, according to the coroner.

Lancaster spoke but a few words before dying. While lying on the sidewalk he said to Tackberry, "You got me the first time," meaning that the first shot fired in the hall upstairs took effect. He was then remonstrated with the detectives who were searching his pockets, when they removed \$115 from a trousers' pocket.

Jewelry May Be From East. None of the rings, watches, costly bracelet-brace, 13 woolen blankets or 17 oriental rugs found at the place are identified as belonging to Lancaster, who came to Portland to dispose of his wife's. A long list of about \$12,000 worth of jewelry recently purchased in Minneapolis has just been received and detectives are now busy trying to determine if anything found in Lancaster's house answers the description.

Lancaster wore several pieces of clothing which were purchased in Minneapolis and St. Paul. A few of his belongings bore the marks of St. Louis.

Police received the first information about Lancaster from the Montana Assay office, which complained that a man named J. H. Smith had treated the assayer. He had a quantity of jewelry to be melted down. All settings were missing from the rings. Monday he is said to have returned with a second lot.

Lancaster was to return Tuesday, so the police were notified. Inspectors Snow and Tackberry were placed on the scene, but a few minutes before Lancaster appeared at court, subpoena was served on Snow and he had to leave. When Lancaster went to the assayer office Tuesday he carried a box filled with jewelry. He was followed by a letter in the man's pocket the police learned that he had resided at 1906 Fifty-seventh avenue Southeast under the name of McRoberts. He is said to have given another address about two blocks away to friends. The police do not know as yet who was with him in the clearing house at Fort Stevens Stella Evans, 20 years of age, and Emma Clark, 22, were arrested in a hotel at Twelfth and Washington streets under the name of McRoberts. He is said to have given another address about two blocks away to friends.

Finger prints were taken of the man after he died, and these will be sent to the finger print clearing house at Leavenworth to see if any other jail in the nation has a record of the man.
