

VICTIM OF ROBBERY PROPOSES TO UNITE AUTOMOBILE OWNERS

Metzger Asserts Court All Too Lenient With Those Who Have Thieving Habits.

Following the theft of his automobile from in front of the Benson hotel at 10:50 o'clock Tuesday night, W. W. Metzger of the Stanley S. Thompson company has begun the organization of an association of automobile owners to compel more severe penalties for such thefts in the local courts.

"The judges of our courts are directly responsible for the increasing number of automobile thefts," declared Mr. Metzger. "A bill before the legislature would compel judges to sentence auto thieves instead of dismissing them with a mild reprimand. When a boy gets off easily for stealing a car he is not only encouraged to repeat the offense but his moral fibre suffers disintegration and he finds less scruple in stealing any property he may fancy."

Medford, Feb. 13.—The annual Lincoln day banquet, held under the auspices of the Lincoln club of Jackson county, at the Hotel Medford Wednesday night was the usual brilliant gathering of the leading Republicans of the county. About 300 persons were in attendance, and the chief orator of the night was Judge Wallace McCamant of Portland, who paid eloquent tribute to Lincoln, his subject being "Lincoln as the Interpreter."

Among other speakers were Colonel H. H. Sargeant of this city, who paid tribute to the memory of Theodore Roosevelt in a masterly manner. Short talks were given by Mrs. Lee Davenport, formerly of Portland but now a resident of Medford; R. A. Booth of Eugene, state highway commissioner, and Herbert Nunn of Salem, state highway commissioner.

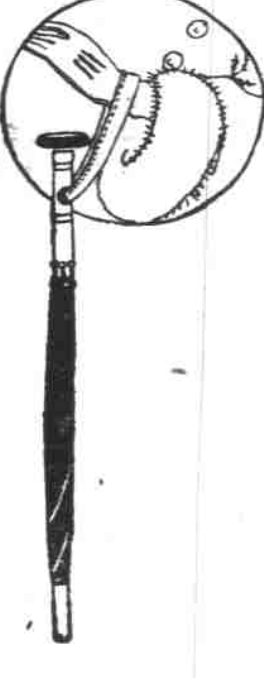
