From Boston came the message that 48 cities and towns in New England had subscribed their quotas up to last night.

ITALIANS TOLD "NO" BY WILSON

"Can't Have Fiume," Is Substance of Statement Which Repudiates the London Pact.

Delegates From Rome Assert President Has Broken Up the Peace Conference by Stand.

PARIS, April 23.—(U. P.)—“President Wilson's statement has broken up the peace conference,” a member of the Italian delegation declared this afternoon.

The delegate said that Premier Orlando will leave for Rome tonight or tomorrow and that the remainder of the delegation will go as quickly as possible thereafter.

Orlando declined to comment on the president's statement beyond intimating that Italy's response might take the form of some definite action. This was interpreted as meaning possible withdrawal.
