

WOOL SALES HERE AGGRESSIVE; MILLS TAKE ALL FLEECE

Portland Auction Monday Most
Successful Held by Govern-
ment in Entire United States.

3,000,000 POUNDS ON SALE

Very Few Clips Are Removed
Because of Price; Price Re-
mains Firm Throughout Buying.

The second government wool auction held in Portland Monday was the greatest success of all the government auctions held in the entire country as regards the small number of clips withdrawn from sale because of price. Not only did prices rise firm for the 3,000,000 pounds of wool on offer, but the bidding was extremely aggressive, with practically the entire allotment taken by the mills and their representatives.

Information Ready For Men Who Would Enter Air Service

Men interested in air service of the army may receive pamphlets describing the service and its opportunities for advancement, according to an announcement made by Captain Charles J. Glidden in the following telegram:

"All men who wish to take part in the development in the nation's air service as an aviator or dirigible balloon pilot, chauffeur, mechanic, or work at some 30 other trades required in the air service, may secure information by sending their names and address to the Department, Air Service Officer, 104 Broad street, New York, N. Y. They will immediately receive an important communication on the subject which I have prepared after serving as an officer several months in the United States army flying school at Southern Field, Americus, Ga., and at the United States army balloon school at Fort Omaha, Nebraska."

Two-Cent Rate in Oregon Granted to G. A. R. Encampment

A rate of two cents a mile from all points in Oregon to The Dalles G. A. R. encampment and meeting of allied societies from June 17 to 19 has been specially arranged by the local passenger committee of the railroad administration. This rate will be effective both to and from the encampment and will be sold from June 13 to 17 inclusive.

The tickets will be sold only on presentation of identification certificates signed by the state department commander of Oregon. The special tickets will be valid for return until midnight of June 25.
