METHODISTS NEAR GOAL IN CAMPAIGN FOR \$105,000,000

Special Announcement Will Be Made Sunday Morning to Congregation at First Church.

DR. STANSFIELD TO TALK Moral and Spiritual Delinquency Will Be Discussed With Reference to Those Who Don't Try

First Methodist church is rapidly nearing her quota in the Methodist centenary drive for \$105,000,000 for home and foreign missionary work and \$50,000,000 for reconstructive work in the war weary and devastated countries of Europe.

Sunday morning Dr. Stansfield will discuss the causes of moral and spiritual delinquency and will try to point out the way to avoid them. "To free oneself of moral and spiritual delinquency is to relieve oneself of a debilitating factor in this life and the life to come," Dr. Stansfield said.

In the evening Dr. Stansfield will preach on "Profit and Loss—A Question in Moral Mathematics." This sermon will be a character study in the lives of those who lose; those who fail; those who never try; those who have had, those who fall have tried to have, but those who never try: what of them?

FEAST OF PENTECOST SERVICES JUNE 4

Feast of Weeks Will Be Celebrated in All Synagogues on That Date.

Special festival services will be held in all Jewish houses of worship, Wednesday, June 4 (in orthodox synagogues also on the fifth) for the Feast of Weeks or Pentecost, known to the Jews as Shabouth. The name derives from the fact that the festival falls seven weeks or 50 days after the beginning of the Passover festival.

The Reform synagogue, stressing this historical feature, which commemorates the dedication of the ancient Israelites to the faith in One God and the highest morality, have introduced the Confirmation service in which the youth of the congregation have been specially instructed in their history and their faith, express before the congregation their understanding of and their loyalty to the religion of their fathers.
