

STRIKING OPERATORS GET JOBS WITH MORE PAY, SAYS SECRETARY

That Many Telegraphers Will Not
Return After Walkout Is Over,
Is Belief of Preston.

"Many men of the Portland local of the Commercial Telegraphers' union, who are striking, are taking other unskilled jobs at shorter hours and about 30 per cent more pay," this morning declared C. H. Preston, Sr., deputy international president.

"Our workers are going into the shipyards, leaving the trade they have followed for years and in which they have become experts, and are taking up work in which they are entirely unskilled. They now get a day off every week, whereas in working for the Western Union they did not, and they get Saturday afternoons off, though they did not before, and they are getting considerably more money. Their lowest wages are \$4.65 a day, whereas they only drew \$3.50 a month from the telegraph company."

"One of the women strikers who was drawing \$55 a month from the Western Union has taken a position in another concern for \$80 a month. We are placing strikers in other work just as rapidly as possible and we can still place two more right now."

"All this simply means that many of these people will never go back to the telegraph company even when the strike is over. The telegraph company by refusing to pay a proper or even a living wage, are simply lowering the standard of efficiency of their workers and taking in cheaper and less competent labor."

"There is still a possibility of the broker operators striking, though probably not till June 30, as they have a contract which does not expire till then and the union does not want them to violate their contract."

Pacific Fleet to Leave East Coast For West Aug. 1

Washington, June 20.—(U. P.)—Movement of the new Pacific fleet from the Atlantic coast will be begun by August 1. Secretary of the Navy Daniels said today.

The fleet will be practically formed before it starts through the canal but will be joined by a few ships on the Pacific side.

Secretary Daniels may accompany the fleet. He will visit the Pacific coast in August and hopes to be able to sail with the warships. Vessels that will make up the fleet are not yet known, Daniels said, with the exception of the battleship Idaho. This ship, after taking President Pessoa of Brazil home early in July, will return via the Panama canal. It is expected to reach the Pacific coast ahead of the rest of the fleet.

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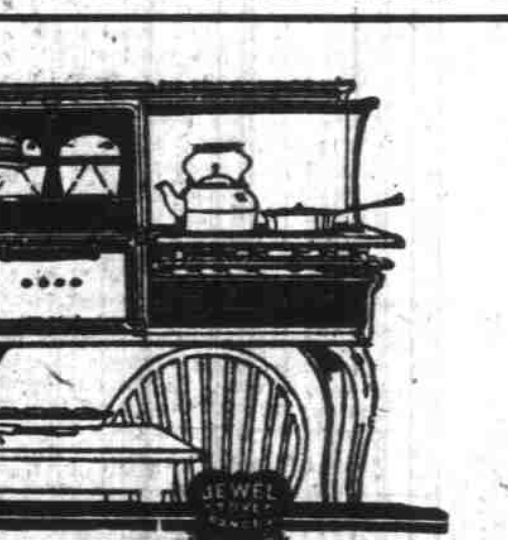
