

NORTH WEST BOYS NEAR DISCHARGE

Returning Overseas Soldiers Pass Through Portland Bound for Camp Lewis.

Sixty-six overseas soldiers, members of the 6th division and residents of Oregon and Washington, passed through the city Friday night en route to Camp Lewis for discharge. The men are of the 5th infantry, 6th field signal battalion, and the 11th field artillery. They arrived in the United States June 10 on the transport Mt. Vernon and left Camp Mills for the West June 15. They arrived in the city at about 7:30 and, after a supper served by the official reception committee of the Benson and a dance at Cottell hall, departed for Camp Lewis at 11 o'clock.
