

BERRY PICKERS ARE STILL BADLY NEEDED TO SUPPLY DEMANDS

Nine Hundred Women Secured, but 1100 Places Unfilled; Coos Bay Needs Men.

Temporary slackening of the demand for farm labor in and about Portland is noted in Monday's report of the United States employment bureau here, issued by Wilfred F. Smith.

"This is doubtless accounted for," says Mr. Smith, "by the fact that this is the period between haying and harvest—haying being mostly over and harvest yet to begin—nearly always a dull period."

"There is no demand above the supply for mechanics in the building trades, either wood or metal workers. In the lumber and logging camps and mills the supply of help is almost, if not quite, equal to the demand. In regard to shipyard work, the same conditions prevail—there being no scarcity of mechanics or helpers. From present indications there will be little change in the labor situation during the next two weeks, or until after the fourth of July."

SHORTAGE AT COOS BAY
"At Medford there will be little work in the orchards from now on until picking of early pears begins about August 10 or 15."
"In the Coos Bay district there is a shortage of common labor, caused by new work opening up. This shortage is likely to increase during the next 60 days, or until the harvest season is over. Laboring men are coming in from California, which relieves the situation. Two sawmills now in operation expect to put on night shifts soon after the first of July. New contracts under which work will soon begin will also create new demands for labor. The employment situation in this district is entirely satisfactory."

BERRY PICKERS NEEDED
"The loganberry crop this year will break all records and give employment to thousands of women and girls. Growers have come or sent orders from Salem, Newberg, Gervais, Brooks and Gresham. The filling of these orders has been left principally to the women's division, where 900 pickers have already been booked for various camps, and requests for 1100 remain unfilled to this date. It is expected that orders for at least 200 more will be received during the next 10 days, this estimate being based on the business of the last week."

Winnipeg Strike Called Off After Weeks of Turmoil

Winnipeg, June 25.—(I. N. S.)—Exactly six weeks from the date of its beginning the Winnipeg general strike will come to an end. Leaders of the strike have ordered the men to return to work tomorrow at 11 o'clock. The strike became effective at 11 o'clock on the morning of May 15.

The decision to call off the strike was reached after several weeks of mediation and was the result of an agreement between the strikers and officials of the provincial government whereby the government will appoint a commission to investigate and settle all disputes.

Among the problems to be settled as a result of the strike is the question of the standing of policemen who were discharged by the city for refusing to sign a pledge not to join in any sympathetic strike. It is expected that labor will demand these policemen be restored to duty. Winnipeg has been policed for more than a month by returned soldiers and special constables.
