

CONTRACTORS PAYING AS HIGH AS \$4.50 FOR HIGHWAY WORK LABOR

Approach of Harvest Season and Scarcity of Men Causes Increase in Wages.

Albany, July 11.—Owing to the approach of the harvest season and the scarcity of labor generally, the paving contractors on the Pacific highway are paying as high as \$4.50 per day for common labor and are experiencing difficulty in getting men at that price.

The heavy crop in this section is exceptionally good and many of the farm boys who were working on the highway and elsewhere between seeding and harvest are giving up their jobs to help the folks at home harvest.

The paving plant of the Kern Construction company at Jefferson is rapidly nearing completion and the work of paving the highway between there and Albany will begin soon.
