

WINNEPEG WHEAT GRADE RESUMPTION SHOWS KEEN DEMAND FOR EGG ADVANCE HERE IS THE RESULT OF HOT WEATHER DEMANDS

The advance being quoted all through the egg trade at this time is to some extent caused by weather conditions. Hot weather, which always decreases the consumption of meats and increases the eating of eggs, is having its effect. With bidding as high as 47c a dozen for hot receipts from the better known shippers, the price here has touched the extreme high mark for the season to date.
