Wool Market Is Better in Boston

Wool Grower Alleged to Get \$4.50 for Fleece Contained in the Average Suit of Clothes

Charge of profiteering in clothing is passed on to other places by the Producer-Manufacturers Have Been Besieged With Orders for Supplies.

Who's profiteering? Apparently everyone in the class these days, except, perhaps, the salaried man, and even the "bosses" are in most instances willing to admit that.

The cost of provisions is, as everyone knows, high everywhere in the world, the foodstuffs situation appears beyond relief, at least for the time being.

The woolen mills men, the clothing manufacturers, the wholesalers, and the retailers are being charged with profiteering by Dr. McClure, well known as secretary of the National Wool Growers' association, says the cost of high priced clothing cannot by any means be charged directly or indirectly to the producer of fleeces. He has an alibi that is iron clad.

Dr. McClure recently made the statement that the average wool grower did not receive as much for his wool this season as a year ago, and that the entire value of the wool in the average suit of clothes, based upon the Idaho clip, was not more than \$4.50 to the producer.

Considering the fact that the sheep owner is today in many instances forced to pay the herders about \$30 a month "and found," which means perhaps an additional \$35 a month, as compared with \$20 and \$45 a few years ago, and the board costing about \$15 added, the wool grower is quickly taken out of the profiteering class.

Good Demand Brings a Premium Manufacturing interests have been able to command almost any price for their goods during the last few years. In fact, it is openly charged that many manufacturers take orders for certain deliveries at a stated price and then someone comes along who is in a hurry for the goods and pays a liberal premium over this amount.

Therefore the first order at the lower price is either cancelled or else greatly delayed in filling. In a public statement Dr. McClure says there is an actual surplus of wool instead of a shortage in this country. Other interests do not agree with him, and the fact that the wool is being sold at a price that is continuing to rise, and that strong abroad, indicates that if the wool is available the biggest buyers in the business do not know where it is located.

PRODUCE MARKET IS GENERAL Y. HOLDING ESTABLISHED PRICE

Yakima Is Underselling Local Potato Growers and Is Getting the Business—Dairy Products Situation Attracts Much Attention.

There was a generally steady tone in the wholesale produce markets for the week. The potato situation is today attracting much attention because of the selling here of such liberal supplies of Yakima stock, while only about 10 per cent of the sales of this state's growth.

There are two reasons for this condition. Potato growers of Oregon have not kept pace with other districts and have allowed quality to deteriorate, and they are by no means disposed to accept competitive quotations for their supplies.

Yakima Potatoes Get Business. That Portland is buying much more Yakima potatoes than it has for some time is known to all in the trade. Owing to the fact that local growers are usually slow about starting their selling season, Yakima growers secured the business. Wholesalers who would purchase the local stock rather than go elsewhere for their needs, have been unable to secure more than a small percent of their requirements in the home territory and were therefore compelled to go elsewhere. The fact that Yakima is looking after its quality is another factor that influences buying there.

Onion Outlook Is Good. With a crop somewhat in excess of the production of a year ago, the season for Oregon onions is being formally opened here. While only small sales have as yet been made here because of the lack of interest on the part of the trade, the outlook is exceedingly favorable so far as volume and price are concerned.

Trade Goes Higher. Portland again secured the government order for supplying the Alaskan railroad commission with eggs. Being a primary marketing center, it is able to pay producers a better price for their supplies and still under-bid other markets. Local egg receipts have been very short recently and the government order naturally has the trade greater strength and forced higher values. Receipts of eastern stock are liberal and withdrawals from storage are increasing materially.

Export Demand Continues to Have Stiffening Effect on Values of Foodstuffs in This Country

European Governments Report Officially That Extreme Shortage Exists, Despite Recent Statement from Herbert Hoover That an Over-abundance of Supplies Is Shown.

The export situation continues to dominate almost entirely the foodstuffs market in the United States. Only by an official order of the United States government, cancelling entirely the exporting of foodstuffs to Europe, can the numerous of this country hope to make a general lowering of values.

That there is a surplus in this country and that huge supplies of foodstuffs are being held by speculators with the hope of securing this foreign demand at extreme prices, is known to those who are in touch with the situation at home.

The shortage of butter, eggs, poultry and meats abroad is serious and there is apparently no hope of diminishing the call from abroad at least during the present season. The recent interview with Herbert Hoover, in which the former food administrator made the claim that Europe was flooded with food, is not borne out by the official reports of the various European governments.

British Controller Analyzes Food Situation. The food situation of the United Kingdom was analyzed by the British food controller at the meeting of representatives of the British press. The following excerpts dealing with the control of foodstuffs, either by statutory order or by agreement with the trade, comprise the substance of his report.

There is a unanimous call, not only for the continuation of the present policy, but for its extension to those commodities from which it has been lifted. I ascribe this demand on the part of the public to the fact that the continuation of control to three causes. Firstly, to the fact that the war has not yet ended and the war prices have not fallen as largely as it had been generally hoped they would; secondly, to the fact that the essential commodities which were never controlled during the war have shown a tendency to go up in price since the war; and, thirdly, there is undoubtedly very grave apprehension as to the course of prices during the coming winter. In these circumstances the government has decided that the ministry of food shall continue for the present to regulate the supply of foodstuffs by means of the various orders and regulations, and distribution of essential commodities, either by statutory order or by arrangement with the trade, comprise the substance of his report.

The articles so controlled will comprise bread, meat, butter, cheese, sugar, fish, eggs, and certain subsidiary foods of which there may be an acute or prospective shortage. The ministry of food will not be necessary to restrict consumption by a revival of the rationing system, but we shall have to control the supply and demand of the case of meat, sugar, and butter, at least.
