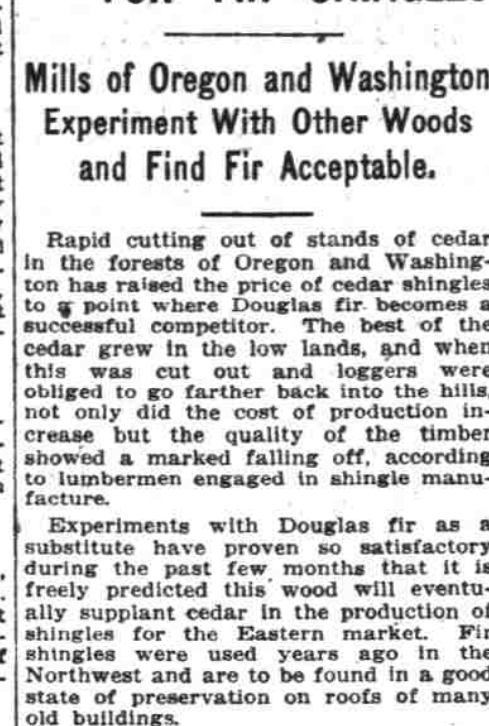
Veteran of Perry Expedition Is Ill
