

WILSON TO GREET PRINCE OF WALES

President Spends Forenoon in
Wheel Chair Writing Message
to the Coming Congress.

Washington, Nov. 13.—(I. N. S.)—President Wilson spent the entire morning in a wheel-chair and did considerable work. Dr. Grayson announced this afternoon. The president was ordered back to bed soon after noon, however, and he will greet the Prince of Wales in the sick room late this afternoon. The president was working on his message to the next congress.

"I am happy to say that I am steadily improving," said President Wilson today, in a cablegram to Alexandria, queen mother of England, replying to her cablegram of yesterday, made public at the White House today.

The queen mother's message said: "I do hope with all my heart that you are feeling stronger now and that the rest after your wonderful work for the benefit of the whole world has given you fresh strength and health for the future. I am glad you were about to spare a moment to see my precious grandson and with kindest remembrance to your wife."

NATION MOURNS FOR 103 BOYS WHO FELL ON BOLSHEVİK FIELD

Tragic Congregation Sees Bodies
Unloaded From Steamer at
New Jersey Wharf.

Hoboken, N. J., Nov. 13.—(I. N. S.)—Beneath gray skies and before a tragic little congregation of weeping relatives, the nation today gave final tribute to 103 young American heroes who had paid their last full measure of devotion on the battlefield amidst the frozen wastes of Northern Russia.

One hundred and three coffins, draped with the flag and almost hidden beneath heaped-up roses, held the mortal remains of the youthful American soldiers who had fallen in action against the Bolshevists on the Archangel front. The bodies had come in on the transport Lake Draga and were lined in solemn tiers upon Pier No. 4, beneath roof beams that were hidden behind folds of black, mournful bunting and the Stars and Stripes.

Between 200 and 300 relatives, mostly from Michigan, wept in inconsolable grief, while men from the foremost ranks of the nation's public men spoke words of glorious praise. About 500 persons in all had gathered for the memorial services, including representatives of the United States senate, the national house of representatives, the state of Michigan, the city of Detroit and the American Legion.
