TAILORS PLAN TO IMPORT WORKERS TO BREAK STRIKE

Merchants Affected by Walkout Determined to Maintain Open Shop, as Association Agreed.

CONTROVERSY GROWS BITTER

Members of Portland Exchange Resent Action of Four Tailoring Firms in Signing Scale.

Portland and other Pacific coast merchant tailors intimate that they intend to "import" tailors and bushmen. In order to maintain the open shop and break the strike of the local unionists, as a result of the agreement arrived at in the conference of the Pacific Coast Merchant Tailors' association in San Francisco last week.

Considerable bitterness is shown by members of the Portland exchange toward the four prominent tailoring firms that signed up with the local union and have been operating with union employees only for several weeks. Although labeled "quitters" and "knuckle-downs" by the open shop adherents, the proprietors of the four establishments are not visibly worried and claim to be operating successfully under the union scale.

20 FIRMS IN EXCHANGE

Merchant tailors who broke away from the exchange are Ray Parkhill, the Portland Tailoring company, Harry Joy of the Unique Tailoring company, and the Charles B. Turlay company. Twenty firms remain in the exchange. Under the old scale tailors received \$24.50 for a 48-hour week. Portland tailors demanded \$40 for a 44-hour week, the scale to apply to tailors and bushmen alike, helpers to receive \$27, according to a statement by A. F. Klein, secretary of the union. Tailors in Seattle and San Francisco demanded \$44 a week for a 44-hour week.

SCALE OFFERED BY EMPLOYERS

The scale offered by all merchant tailors belonging to the association applies to a 48-hour week as follows: Tailors, \$40; tailor's helpers, \$28; bushmen, \$36; bushmen's helpers, \$24; and 10 per cent increase on piece work on coats only.
