

MODERATE FRENCH SOCIALISTS LEAVE RADICAL FACTION

Dissenters to Run on Independent Ticket Now Rather Than Bow to Extremists' Policies.

YOUNG ANARCHISTS BLAMED

Majority is Revolutionary and Gradual Reform Will Not Satisfy Their Wild Desires.

Paris, Nov. 12.—I have learned some of the fundamental reasons for the split in the French Socialist party which has just taken place.

Twenty dissenting deputies have declared their intention of running for reelection on a new ticket.

They maintain that the policy of the majority is too radical and Bolshevistic.

"Trouble first arose over the exclusion of several moderates from the Federation de la Seine," said M. Brunel, one of the dissenters.

"During the war they had voted with the government for the cause of the national defense and since the armistice they had refused to sympathize with the Bolshevist excesses in Russia.

This the extremist majority regarded as treason to the cause. With their views, however, we agreed and therefore had to support the men who had expressed them, and we demanded their reinstatement.

The majority refused and, in consequence, a concrete example of the facts to which we objected is the candidacy of Captain Sadoul on the Socialist ticket.

This man is in Russia and represents all that is bad in Bolshevism. He will probably be condemned to death by a Paris court-martial. We could not see our way clear to urge votes for such a candidate.

Besides this we disapprove of Bolshevism per se as expressed in Russia. We are moderate reformers and want to introduce gradually and not by violence such measures as government ownership, proletarian rule, socialization of industry and so on.

We believe in parliamentary government but not in councils of soldiers and workmen. Under certain circumstances we can cooperate with the bourgeoisie.

"On the other hand, the majority is revolutionary in its sentiments. It wishes to introduce Russian Bolshevism into France, to destroy the existing fabric of society. It will not listen to slow, gradual reforms.

YOUNG ANARCHISTS BLAMED

Among the leaders are a number of wild young anarchists who wish to go to the last extremity. It is unfortunately they who have succeeded in winning the majority of the Federation de la Seine over to their views, and through it the Socialist party as well.

With them cooperation is impossible. We will remain independent until the moderates control as they did during the war.

This dissension has important political significance. In a large measure it destroys the power which the Socialist party has possessed in the chamber of deputies since 1914. Now that their unity has been destroyed the Socialists will no longer be regarded as the strongest group in parliament and bourgeois cabinets will no longer have to make such large concessions to get the cooperation of the Socialist leaders.

In short, the parliamentary balance of power has been changed in favor of the center.

Italian Newspapers Lose Confidence in Fiume Settlement

Trieste, Italy, Nov. 13.—Italian newspapers show a tendency to descend from their lofty pedestal of exaltation over the Fiume situation.

The propaganda is less intense and anxiety is shown over the reported inability of the peace conference and Tittoni to reach an agreement. However, all concur in showing satisfaction over the apparent inability to oust Lieutenant Colonel D'Annunzio from Fiume, whatever solution may be found.

In the different circles it is expected that a crisis will be reached in a few days.

Some alarm is expressed over a report that Serbia has called classes for "military exercise." The Italians still have 2,000,000 men mobilized, including a great number of higher rank officers.

Apparently, this is due more to fear of social trouble caused by lack of work for the soldiers than by the prospect of military action.

It is reported here that owing to the lack of discipline among the troops in East Fiume the Italians will evacuate the territory as far as the bridge connecting Fiume with Sussak, the Jugoslavs, with the consent of the Italians, occupying Sussak. It is also reported that Italian soldiers are deserting their posts to have a good time in Fiume.
