

# SHRINE SUNSHINE SPREADS WARMTH UPON PORTLAND

Imperial Potentate and Official Nobles Lend Their Dignity to Local Demonstration Arranged.

DESERT SANDS CROSSED

Governor Olcott and Bishop Sumner Included in Class of Candidates; Banquet Arranged.

A storm of Shrine sunshine that descended upon Portland Thursday with the arrival of Imperial Potentate Freeland and other official nobles of the Ancient Arabic order, Nobles of the Mystic Shrine, broke Thursday night into pleasant clouds of joy for nearly 600 Shriners who made Portland an oasis of life throughout that day.

After it was all over—and that means, Shriners say today, after the biggest day in Portland's Shrine history—Kendrick declined to say just how much sleep he had enjoyed, for the "wee sma' hours" had dawned before the ancient Arabic nobles ceased their fun making. Western pleasure of Thursday, Kendrick and his traveling companions with Mrs. Kendrick and the others of the official party, saw and were conquered by the Columbia river highway, over which they started a tour at 11 a. m.

**BANQUET IS ARRANGED**

Returning from the highway late this afternoon the Shrine visitors will be guests at a formal banquet at the Multnomah hotel. At 11:30 p. m. the visitors will depart for San Francisco.

Notable, not only for the fraternal personages it brought to the city, but for its salutary effect upon interest in the great national Shrine convention to be held in Portland next spring, the visit of Potentate Kendrick was made a holiday of festival delight for Shriners. Accompanied by Mrs. Kendrick, as well as by Ellis Lewis Garretson, deputy imperial potentate of Affili temple, Tacoma, and Imperial Treasurer Brown of Pittsburgh, Pa., the Shrine party arrived in Portland Thursday morning.

A busy day, featured by a street pageant which proved itself both splendid and ludicrous, was marked by a pretentious three-ring circus at the Army in the afternoon, where a large class of Shrine neophytes toughened their tender feet upon the heated sands of the Shrine Sahara.

**PLEASURE IS UNALLOYED**

That it was a gala evening and an even more gala night, visiting Shriners testified their appreciation to Al Kader temple of Portland.

Among the Portland members of the class of candidates initiated Thursday night were Governor Ben W. Olcott and Bishop Walter Taylor Sumner of the Episcopal church, both of whom found delight in their vigorous reception at

the hands of the band of nobles. The ceremonial session was terminated when refreshments were served the Shriners at the Auditorium. The service followed the presentation to Potentate Kendrick of a great bear robe and the gift of Indian blankets to other visiting Shrine officials.

"I am happily looking forward to the 1920 convention of the Shrine in Portland," Kendrick said today. "The entertainment offered here Thursday and that planned for today indicates what we may expect at the great conclave. I feel that we may well predict one of the biggest of all Shrine conventions."

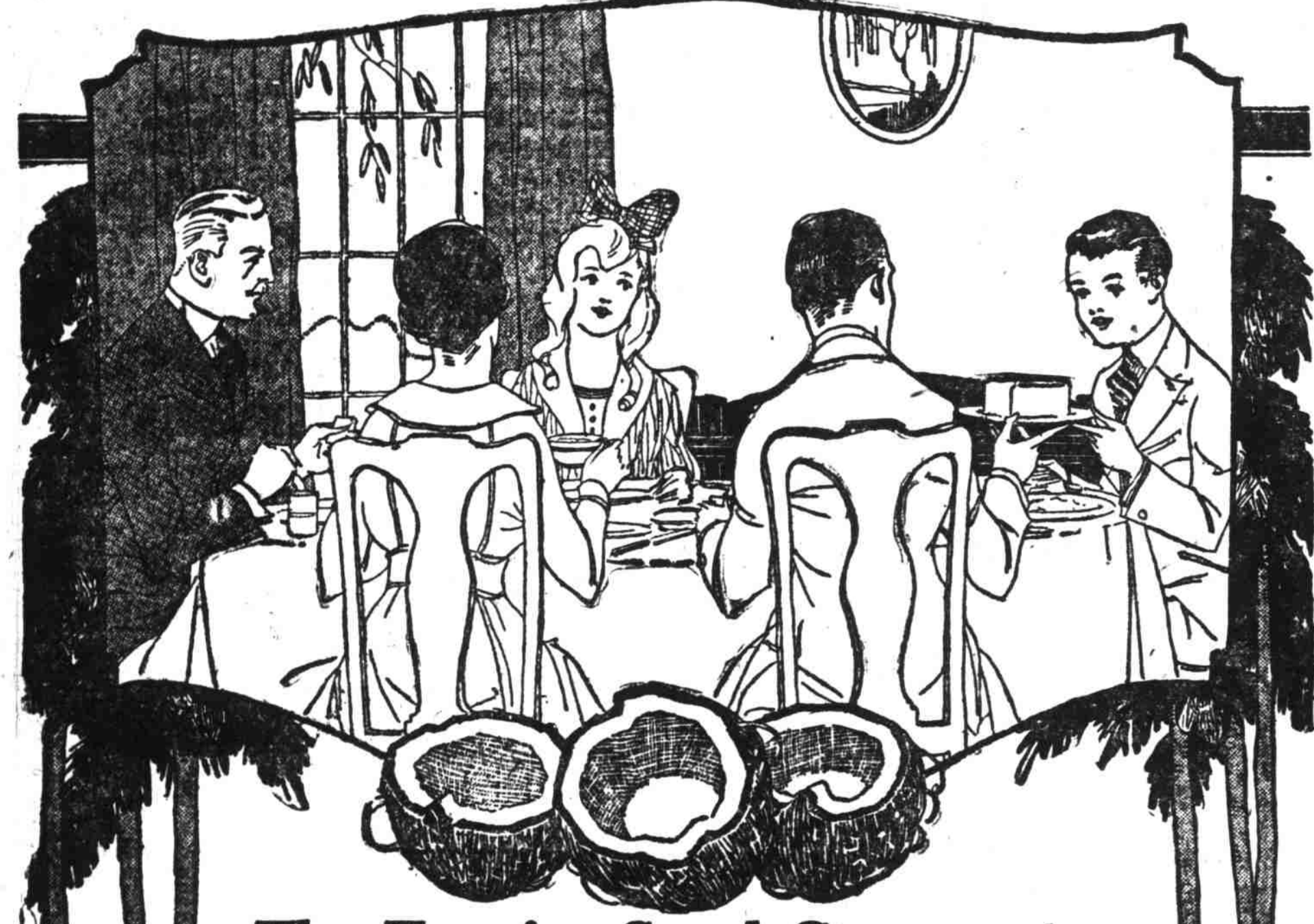
