

DEMOCRATIC HEAD WILL SOON LEAVE FOR WASHINGTON

Dr. Morrow, Chairman of National Committee for Oregon, Expects Big Time at Meeting.

Dr. J. W. Morrow, Democratic national committee chairman for Oregon, will leave for Washington, D. C., immediately after the first of the year to attend the scheduled meeting of the national committee to be held in that city January 8. He will be accompanied by Mrs. Morrow.

It has been planned by National Chairman Cummings to make the meeting of the national committee a notable affair, and in line with this plan it has been set for January 8, Jackson day. The meeting will be featured by a banquet and celebration of the anniversary as a fitting close to the business meeting of the committee.

TO FIX CONVENTION PLACE

The time and the place of the national convention will be fixed by the committee when it meets, that being, in fact, the chief reason for having called the committee together at the time stated.

Ralph E. Williams, Republican national committee chairman, will leave for Washington Wednesday morning, accompanied by Mrs. Williams, to attend the meeting of the Republican committee called by National Chairman Hays for December 10. The date and place of the Republican convention will be fixed by the committee at its meeting. Leaders of the two committees have been jockeying back and forth for some time in an effort to win the last date for holding their respective national conventions.

It has been the usual practice of the Democratic leaders in years gone by to set the date of their conventions subsequent to that chosen by their adversaries. This does not meet with the approbation of the Republican committee men, who contend that the other party is thus able to digest the platform adopted by the Republicans and so shape theirs that they may take advantage of any strategic slip or stumble the Republicans might make.

REPUBLICAN DATE LATER

Accordingly the Republican committee men have been attempting to figure out a plan by which they might be able to engineer the Democrats into setting their convention date first, thus giving them a chance to choose a later time.

The attempt has apparently been abandoned, however, since the Republican committee has been called to meet in December, while the Democratic committee is to meet a month later. It is the belief of Williams that the Republican convention will be called to meet between June 4 and 15, though he has no guess as to the place. Dr. Morrow has no fixed idea as to the probable date of the Democratic convention or the place.

Boston, Dec. 4.—(I. N. The steamer Arammore was reported ashore on St. Mary's island in the Gulf of St. Lawrence, with the crew taking to the boats. The second message from the steamer Prussia stated that the British schooner St. Clair Thurlau was in distress off Cape Sable with the crew ill and two men suffering from broken legs.

Yakima Firemen to Get Wage Increase

Yakima, Wash., Dec. 4.—An increase of \$10 a month in salaries of new and second year men on the fire department, raising the minimum from \$110 to \$120 a month, effective December 1, was adopted by the city commission. The schedule now in effect is that asked at the time of the recent strike.

Former Idaho Treasurer Paroled

Boise, Dec. 4.—O. V. Allen, former state treasurer who confessed embezzlements approximating \$23,000, and who was sentenced in 1914 to serve from five to 10 years in prison, was paroled Wednesday by the state pardon board. Allen has repeatedly sought unconditional pardon.

Washington Officer Arrested Accused of Violating Game Law

Frank Smith, a fire warden from Washington, was fined \$25 in the district court Wednesday afternoon, for violating the Oregon game laws by importing a deer into the state that was not properly tagged. The deer was brought from Plain, in Northeastern Washington, and was distributed among Smith's friends in Portland.

Discovery that the deer was brought into the state illegally was made by Ed Clark and T. J. Craig, deputy game wardens, when they were summoned to the home of one of Smith's friends to tag a portion of the deer. The anxiety of the friend to comply with one state game law therefore led to the arrest of Smith.
