

ANOTHER ATTEMPT MADE TO MURDER IRISH VICE REGAL

Guard and One Attacker Killed
and Five Arrested in Daring
Attempt to Assassinate French.

Dublin, Dec. 29.—(U. P.)—Lieutenant Boast was killed accidentally by the military, a coroner's jury decided at the inquest over Boast's body here today. The jury returned its verdict after questioning soldiers who were with Boast when he was shot early yesterday on the vice-regal grounds here.

Dublin, Dec. 29.—The member of the party that attacked the Vice Regal lodge early Sunday morning and was shot dead by Lord French's guards, was identified last night as Lawrence Carey of Duncannon. He had been recently treated at a Dublin hospital for an injury to his head.

Lieutenant Boast, in charge of the lodge guard, was killed by a bullet by one of the attackers. The latter was dressed in a British army uniform. Soldiers chased him and killed him with shotguns. The attack was a second attempt to assassinate the lord lieutenant of Ireland. The attack was evidently planned with great care. The would-be assassins had arranged themselves in the main road a quarter of a mile from the lodge and suddenly opened fire on the vice-regal residence in the hope, it is believed, that their bullets would enter the windows and by chance hit the viceroy.

Lieutenant Boast traced the fire, and with two soldiers closed in on the assassins. Holiday merrymakers were playing in the park, unaware that a battle was going on in their midst until hours later when blood stains and bullet grooves were discovered in the roadside. Three hours after the attack five men were arrested while trying to leave Phoenix park, which was surrounded by a cordon of armed guards.

LONDON PAPER ASKS PREMIER TO FORCE NEW IRISH BILL

London, Dec. 29.—The government should go "steadily forward" with its plan to enforce Premier Lloyd George's home rule plan for Ireland, despite yesterday's apparent renewal of a "reign of terror," the Daily Chronicle declared today.

Because of the mystery surrounding the latest outbreak, in which Lieutenant Boast of the British army, and Laurence Carey, a civilian, were killed in a clash between soldiers and civilians on the vice-regal grounds at Dublin, newspaper comment here today generally was guarded. The Chronicle considered the incident "not significant."

OBJECT LESSON SEEN
"If the Sinn Féin want to prevent Ulster's consent to be ruled by an Irish parliament, it could not provide a better object lesson," in the opinion of the Daily Graphic.

Times blamed Lord Lieutenant French, the Irish viceroy, as well as Sinn Féin leaders. The lord lieutenant's hesitation to condemn such acts has made the situation worse, in the opinion of this newspaper.

The newspapers were inclined to view with some suspicion the news that the latest shooting affray resulted when Irish radicals attempted to raid the vice-regal lodge, presumably for a second attempt on the life of Lord French.

MAY DENY RAID STORY

It was intimated denial of the raid story may be forthcoming and that possibly the killing of both Lieutenant Boast and Carey was a fatal mistake.

There was one story that Carey, with a party of civilians, was returning home near Phoenix park when he was seized by soldiers. In the general excitement, it was said, both sides started shooting.

According to another story, Carey seized Boast by the throat and precipitated the fight.

CITIZENS TO BE DRAFTED AS POLICE TO QUELL RIOTS

London, Dec. 29.—A report circulated Sunday says hundreds of London policemen have been or will be drafted to reinforce the police in Dublin, in anticipation of serious outbreaks there. The report is officially denied.

REGIONAL DIRECTOR OF RAILROADS ASKS THAT CARS BE SENT TO UNEMPLOYED CAUSED IN PACIFIC NORTHWEST BY CLOSING DOWN OF LUMBER MILLS.

Salem, Dec. 29.—R. H. Ashton, regional director of the federal railroad administration, is appealing to a telegram forwarded by the public service commission, to use his influence in diverting a larger number of cars to the Pacific Northwest in an effort to relieve the present unemployment situation which is said to be greatly aggravated by reason of the inability of mills to ship their output necessitating closing down of many plants and incidentally throwing many men out of work.

"An already serious car shortage in Oregon and throughout the Northwest, augmented by recent storms, has restricted business operations generally, and practically shut down our immense lumber industry which not only throws thousands out of employment and causes heavy financial losses, but also tends to maintain and force prices upward," the appeal to Ashton reads.

"Can you not in this emergency assist by allocating and diverting a greater number of cars to the Pacific Northwest? This commission has no general complaint on local distribution in this territory, but does believe that drastic remedies should be applied to Missouri river points and east to speed up movement and materially increase number of westbound supplies. This commission, by circular and otherwise, with Northwest officials cooperating, is urging capacity load, prompt releases and other remedies, but we feel that our present situation is hopeless unless we can secure local control and demands summary action by authorities responsible for car distribution. We suggest full use of all shops, private or otherwise, for car construction and prompt repairs to bad order cars; also continued efforts to speed up road and yard movements, with expedited delivery and release and heavier loads upon the cars, where necessary for priority movement of coal, foodstuffs and perishables, but at the same time mention that considerable portion of our grain crop remains in warehouses and that there is a demand for refrigerators. Please advise action taken."

Another auto was damaged on Holiday avenue because of the driver's carelessness. He was following a street car on Holiday, turned to pass the car on the left side, and was struck by a street car bound in the opposite direction.

An automobile was proceeding north on Union avenue and at Oregon street another machine came into the intersection from the left. It struck the auto bound north on Union and drove it into a pole, slightly injuring the driver. The police charged the second machine with reckless driving.

Speed was the cause of an accident at East Twenty-fourth and Everett streets, say the police, in which two women were seriously injured. Tuesday. The machine in which they were riding came into the intersection at such speed that it was impossible to avoid collision. The driver is held by the police.

A motorcycle and machine collided at Fourth and Harrison. The motorcycle was speeding and could not stop to give right of way to the automobile.

When a fire blew out, an automobile was temporarily parked on Broadway bridge. While the machine was at a standstill another car bumped into the rear. The driver admitted that he simply failed to allow enough room for his car.

A machine was bound west on Couch, and another north on the left side of Everett. The one on Couch was almost across the intersection when the auto on the left side of the street crashed squarely into it without an attempt to turn.

A driver failed to slow up when approaching Broadway at Taylor, and dashed into the side of a street car. This is only part of the story of a single day's accidents and their causes. There were 23 like smashups during the day. Part were caused by the carelessness of pedestrians, the remainder by carelessness or recklessness of drivers. Pedestrians stepped into the path of cars and jockeyed to one side and the other. Machines went into intersections at high speed and out of control. They attempted the impossible, and failed.

These things are reasons for smashups. When the pedestrian guards his step and crosses at the intersection at the proper time, and automobiles are under control and allowance is made for mistakes of pedestrians and other drivers, automobile accidents will rapidly dwindle in Portland.
