

AFRICA, EN ROUTE TO PORTLAND, IS HALTED BY FOG

Big Government Transport at Columbia City Coming From Hawaii for Flour Cargo.

Because of the fog in the lower Columbia river, there is little chance of the big government transport Marica reaching Portland harbor today.

Major Tingley, officer in charge of the quartermaster's office, received a telegram from the master of the Marica at noon, stating that the vessel had anchored all night near Columbia City, just above St. Helens, and was still there.

The Marica is coming to Portland from Pearl Harbor, to load flour and cargo of flour for an unnamed destination in the Atlantic. Her cargo of more than 10,000 cubic tons will be the largest flour shipment ever sent from Portland.

Establishing a record which it is believed has never been equaled in the Northwest, the shipping board steamer West Hassayampa was furnished a capacity cargo of flour at Portland mills in five days.

It was announced at the offices of the grain corporation today that the shipping board steamer Duquesne, coming from Pearl Harbor, is to load flour and cargo of the Portland mills and complete loading at Astoria.
