

STOWAWAYS HELD IN U. S. TRANSPORT ESCAPE TO DOCK

Found on Board Marica from Honolulu; One of Greatest Cargo Carriers in Portland.

The anxiety of three mascots on board the United States army transport Marica, to set foot on the United States was probably the omen that brought about the record passage of seven days made by the big stowaway from Honolulu to the Columbia river, say the ship's officers.

But the same anxiety on the part of the mascots, three very active young American stowaways, brooked no delay in their landing after the vessel docked. Despite the fact that they were behind locked doors, for some time Thursday night they broke confinement and escaped to North Bank dock.

Ernest O'Donnell and Jack Holmes, both residents of California, and Joe Dunsmore of Altona, Pa., slipped aboard at Honolulu and hid in No. 8 hold, according to G. Hodge, first officer.

APPEAR SUDDENLY TO EAT

One day out at sea, they calmly appeared on deck, announcing that their appetites were troubling them. Hodge ordered them held and put to work. After the Willamette Thursday afternoon the boys were confined in the isolation ward of the sick bay to await the immigration officers in Portland.

The latter promised to take charge of the stowaways this morning. They appeared, but the birds had been locked during the night they took the lock off the door and, finding the gateway to the dock guarded, said to land by the stern lines.

The Marica, while not the largest vessel ever in port, is among the first three

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NEW FREIGHTERS ASSIGNED

Federal Contract Finished When Two Boats Are Launched.

The last of the government contract steel freighters built in Portland under the shipping board program were definitely assigned this morning by C. D. Kennedy, local agent for the division of operations of the shipping board. These are the Standford boats Pawlet and Bearport, both of which are still on the ways at Vancouver. The Bearport was assigned to the Pacific Coast Pacific Shipping company for a grain administration cargo to New York. The Pawlet goes to the Pacific Steamship company for February sailing in the Portland-Orient line.

The Pawlet is promised ready for service on February 15 and the Bearport February 20.
