Requests for tickets have already begun to reach state headquarters from outside counties.

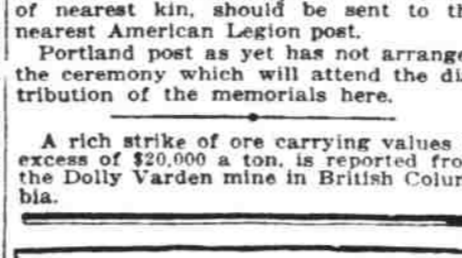
