

HAMBY DECLARED SING SING'S MOST AMAZING PRISONER

Electrocution Faces Bank Robber Tonight, But He Sleeps Well and Asserts He Is Ready.

Ossining, N. Y., Jan. 29.—(I. N. S.)—Although Gordon Fawcett Hamby, iron-nerved bank robber, murderer and prisoner of mystery, walked in the very shadow of death today, he was cheerful and gave no signs of breaking down. Unless a last minute reprieve comes from Governor Smith, Hamby will be electrocuted in Sing Sing prison shortly after 11 o'clock tonight for the murder of two bank clerks in Brooklyn in 1918.

Watchers in the Sing Sing prison death house said that Hamby had slept amazingly well for a man who is spending his last night on earth. He is the most remarkable prisoner that Sing Sing has ever had.

NOT HIS NAME
He insists that Hamby is not his right name, but declared that he would go to his death "on time" without revealing the secret of his life. He is only 26 years old.

Hamby coolly told the prison officials that he had planned to kill himself, but had decided to "commit legal suicide instead."

"You treated me squarely, warden, and were such a good fellow that I decided to let the law take its course," said the condemned man.

During the last few days in the death house Hamby has been amusing himself with an outboard and a phonograph. He was an inveterate cigarette smoker, but when his supply of tobacco was exhausted he refused to sign the name "Hamby" to an order on his small supply to buy more.

ARRESTED AT TACOMA

Hamby was arrested in Tacoma, Wash., and brought to Brooklyn in June, 1918. He made a confession to the King county district attorney saying he had committed robberies "in every country of consequence on the face of the globe, but had never tackled a job unless there were five figures in it."

He was placed on trial in Brooklyn on June 23, waived all defense and was convicted, three days later.

The only request Hamby made to the court was that the certificate of his death be made to read "Jay B. Allen" instead of Gordon Fawcett Hamby.

Medical men who have examined Hamby declare that he is sane.

Bank's Cooperation To Make Income Tax Return Report Easy

Washington, Jan. 29.—(I. N. S.)—Commissioner Daniel C. Roper announced today that banks and trust companies throughout the United States had given such assurances of cooperation that he looked for 100 per cent results in the next income tax drive.

Revenue field deputies already have begun the task of supplying information and aid to the vast number of persons who must file returns. Mr. Roper said the efforts of field men would be supplemented greatly by banks volunteering to furnish free advisory service during office hours.

Wren and Hoskins To Have 3 Times a Week Mail Service

Washington, D. C., Jan. 29.—In answer to a petition from Postmaster Charles E. Johnson and other residents of Wren, Or., transmitted through Senator McNary, which asked for restoration of the mail route between Wren and Hoskins, the postoffice department has informed the senator that it will issue a

new advertisement for three-times-a-week service between those points. No bidders responded to a previous invitation in September. In reply to the suggestion that the proposal should be for six times a week, the department says the business does not justify it at this time, but if the lesser service is established and a material increase in business is shown, the idea of increasing frequency of service will be considered.
