

# LARGER FAMILIES NEED OF FRANCE, OFFICIAL APPEAL

### Minister of Hygiene Says Problem of Repopulation Is Most Serious One.

Paris, Jan. 30.—(I. N. S.)—"After five years of devoting all our energies to the destruction of life, France is now going to devote the next five years to the creation of life."

This statement was made today by Jules Breton, France's first minister of hygiene and health. M. Breton said he regarded the problem of repopulation as the most important facing the country at this time. Continuing he said: "The child mother problem has two aspects. First, we must endeavor by means of a moral suasion campaign of education to make girls realize the nobility of motherhood; we must adopt measures to compensate infanticide and willful abandonment. The second phase belongs to the governmental domain and we intend to urge upon parliament the necessity of appropriating funds to care for children whose maternity is unknown or unacknowledged. We must also care for unmarried mothers while they are unable to work. "The soaring cost of living has undoubtedly proved a hindrance to marriage, but it is not for the ministry to attack this side of the problem."

# Scathing Attack Is Made on America by London Newspaper

London, Jan. 30.—(I. N. S.)—Another scathing attack upon the United States was printed by the Daily Express today. The newspaper charged America with "financial hostility and quickly scuttling from her share of the world's burden."

The Daily Express again emphasized its original declaration that "it is high time for Europe to organize and block the United States squeezing the European nations any further."

Other London newspapers comment seriously upon the financial situation, but they are less venomous in their tone than the Daily Express.

# Chicago Man Builds 100 Houses at Cost For British Workers

London, Eng., Jan. 30.—Great Britain needs half a million workpeople's houses. For months the politicians have been talking about building these houses.

Meanwhile Harry Gordon Selfridge, formerly of Chicago, has caused a national sensation by announcing that he and some of his associates in the building trade will proceed at once to construct without a penny of profit to anyone 100 first-class workmen's cottages costing the buyers or tenants 310 pounds nominally (about \$150) each or less. This is the cost less a government allowance of 140 pounds, nominally \$70, for each cottage.

The houses will be semi-detached, built of concrete with brick piers and will contain an entrance hall, a parlor, a living room, three bedrooms, a kitchen, bath and a room for laundry. They will be of one story and the dimensions will be about 40 feet by 20 feet.

# ALLEGED SCHEME IS DISCLOSED TO MAKE KAISER U. S. CITIZEN

### Former Hun Head Said to Have Planned to Open Office in Wall Street.

Paris, Jan. 7.—How the ex-kaiser planned a sensational gallery play by casting himself upon the mercy of the American government and people, whereafter he intended to take out American citizenship papers and open an office in Wall Street, and, backed by the German crown treasure, become a captain of industry, was revealed to Universal Service today by a prominent Dutch source.

Misinformation by his Dutch advisers, who hoped thus to rid Holland of the embarrassing guest, Wilhelm Hohenzollern worked out an elaborate scheme whereby he hoped to gain his liberty under the protection of the American flag.

Immediately following the signature of the Versailles treaty, he planned to flee from Holland secretly aboard a yacht, the purchase of which he had already negotiated through a trusted friend in Norway. Once within the three-mile limit of the United States, the imperial ensign was to be hoisted and he would give himself up to the American naval authorities at Hampton Roads, meanwhile issuing a wireless proclamation pleading an immediate audience at the White House, appealing to the charity and sportsmanship of the American people, and asking that a special act of congress be passed making him a citizen in consid-

# Ukrainia Without A Master; Reds Too Busy After Whites

Paris, France, Jan. 30.—News reaching Paris from Ukraina indicates that a curious state of affairs prevails there. General Petlura, the only substantial national figure, has been driven into Polish territory by General Denikin's army and his troops have been scattered to the four winds. Now General Denikin in turn is fleeing before the Bolsheviks, and consequently a large part of Ukraina is left without a master. The reds are too busy chasing the whites to organize the country they have conquered.

According to Red Cross information, however, General Petlura is organizing a Galician legion with Polish support. With this force he hopes to oust the reds from Kiev.
