

FATHER SAVES CHILD WHILE FATHER-IN-LAW CRUSHED BY MACHINE

H. H. Russell, 323 Fourth Street,
May Die; Father Holds Car
From His Little Girl.

While his father-in-law was being crushed under the steering wheel of an overturned car at Washington street and Union avenue, Wednesday afternoon, William Harris held up one side of the machine long enough to save his little daughter, Marie, 6 years old, whose life would have been snuffed out if the car had fallen farther.

H. H. Russell, 323 Fourth street, was extricated from under the steering wheel and taken to the Good Samaritan hospital by the Arrow Ambulance company, where he was found to have an injury to the spine, several broken ribs, and possibly internal injuries. He may die.

Little Marie escaped after all with only slight bruises. Mrs. H. H. Russell and her daughter, Mrs. William Harris, were thrown out of the car and were not seriously injured.

Fined Him \$40 for Having "Stranger's" Booze in His Auto

Merrill Reed, proprietor of a lifeboat construction company in Vancouver, was fined \$40 in the municipal court Wednesday afternoon on a charge of violating the prohibition law by having liquor in his possession.

Reed's arrest followed an accident at Broadway and Everett street on January 28, when his machine collided with an automobile driven by a Japanese. Patrolman Meecham, who made the arrest, testified that he found two bottles of whiskey in Reed's machine after the accident.

Reed told Judge Rossman that the two bottles must have been left in the machine by a passenger he had picked up on the way to town. Judge Rossman seemed to think that even in the excitement of the accident the "mysterious" passenger would probably remember the precious whiskey, and would hardly have left it in the machine. Charges of reckless driving against Reed were dismissed.

Single Legislative Body Is Proposed To Rule in Oregon

Salem, Feb. 5. — A single legislative body of 100 members to sit in continuous session, performing the executive as well as the legislative functions of the state government and drawing salaries of \$5000 each, was suggested by Professor M. A. Magruder of the Oregon Agricultural college in an address at the public library here Wednesday night.

Such a body, he contended, would attract to the service highly capable men and would go a great way toward eliminating many of the ills which now beset state governments. Magruder would also hold national, state and county elections on separate years, to eliminate confusion in the minds of the voters.

A. W. Hewitt, watchman for the Citizens bank, East Alder and Grand avenue, died suddenly Wednesday afternoon in his lodgings above A. W. Lambert & Sons, 404 East Alder street. Chief Deputy Coroner Leo Gotch stated that death was caused by cerebral hemorrhage.

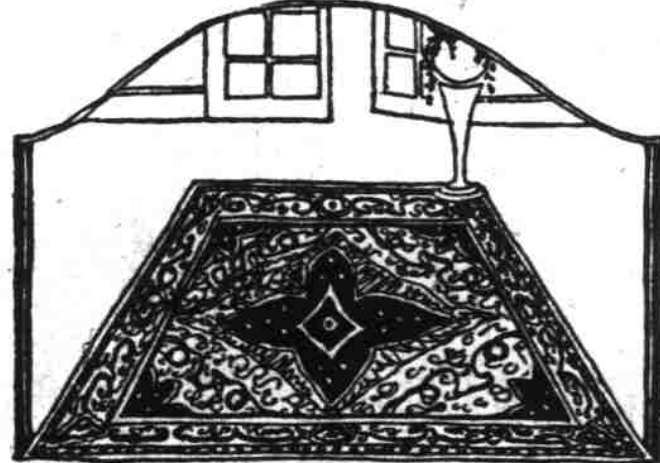
