

BILL TO PROTECT PUBLIC LIBERAL HAND SEEDS EGGS HIGH

Market Shows a Premium Being Paid In Some Instances for Shipment to Atlantic Coast Sections. Because of the rather liberal demand from the East and the desire of the trade to make shipments quickly, premiums of 1 to 2c a dozen are being paid in some instances for eggs here.

While the general buying price at this time ranges at 40c a dozen, eggs here at 41c a dozen has been paid for current receipts by shippers during the last 24 hours.

Butter Shipments Are Good Liberal shipments of butter are being made from Portland to California by this time.

Need Potatoes Moving Here Slight demand for early seed potatoes is shown in the local territory and some sales of early Irish and American Wagon potatoes are being reported.

Tennessee Sweet Potatoes Offering A carload of Tennessee sweet potatoes of the Nancy Hall variety is being offered on the local market at 7c per bushel, 49c per bushel, the first shipment received from that section by the local trade.

Meat Market Prices Shaded Prices are being shaded in the meat markets here for country killed stuff. Most of the sales of best local stuff are being made at a nominal volume, as reported at 21c.
