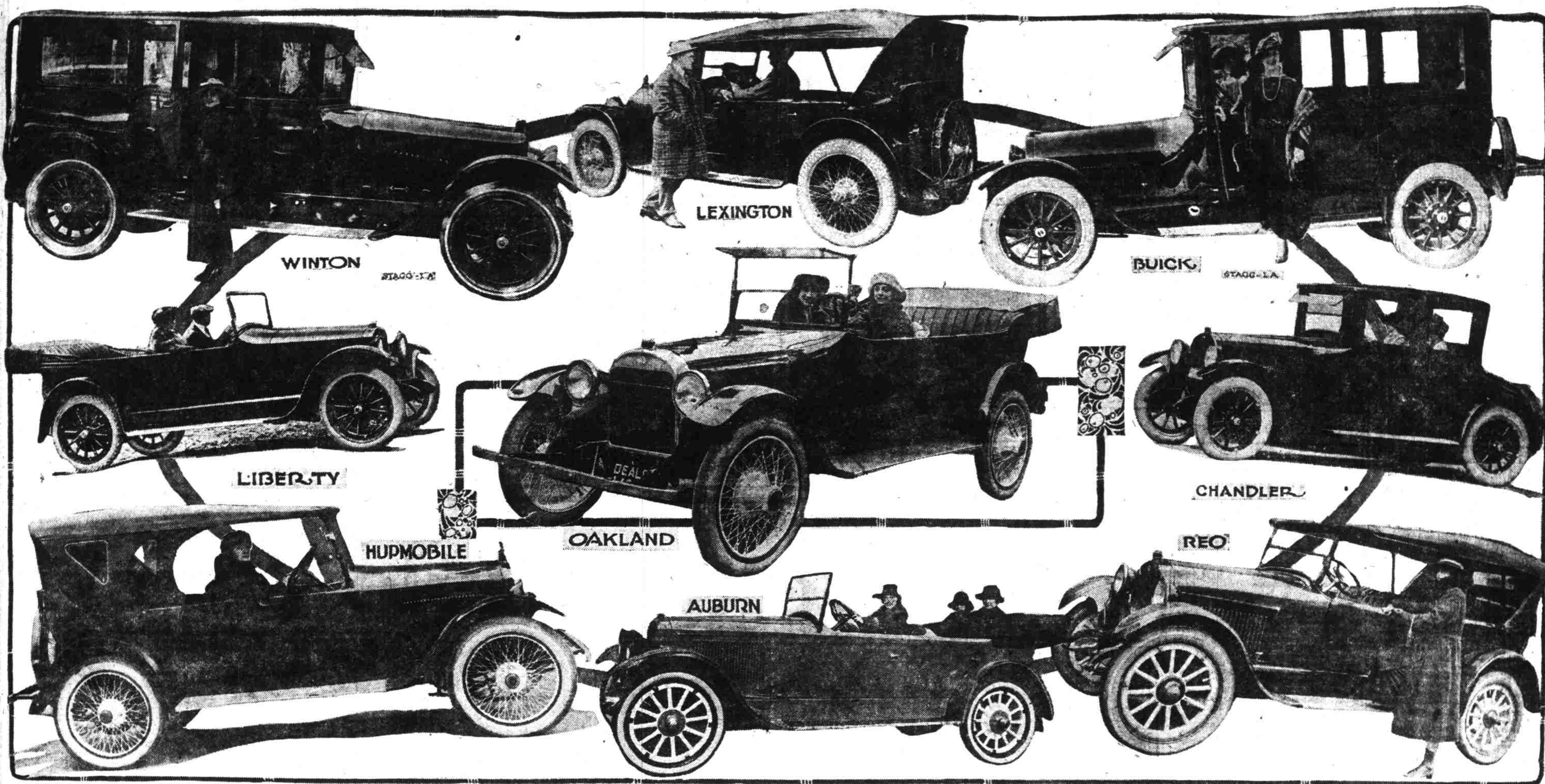


AUTOMOBILES ON SHOW THIS WEEK ARE LAST WORD IN PERFORMANCE



Edge Bill Will Aid U. S. Manufacturers With Foreign Trade

Edge bill, which is in reality an amendment to the federal reserve act, is an excellent move in the right direction. Through this bill American banking facilities will be furnished for export trade. The federal reserve act, as originally passed, provided that national banks having a capital and surplus of \$1,000,000 or more might establish branches in foreign countries. But a

few of the large banks have taken advantage of this provision. It was the feeling that the financing of foreign trade should not be left to the few of the large banks that brought about the amendment giving national banks with a surplus and capital of \$1,000,000 the opportunity to cooperate in the establishment or ownership of foreign banking institutions chartered

under the federal laws. Objects of the act are to facilitate the export of goods, and national banks will now be allowed to subscribe to an amount not exceeding 5 per cent of their capital and surplus, in formation of these export financing.
