

INFLUENZA CLAIMS VICTIMS IN EUGENE; NUMBER ARE ILL

Eugene, Feb. 25.—Lulu Cook, 2 years and 11 months old, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. H. C. Cook of Eugene, died from influenza at the home of a neighbor. Her parents and five brothers and sisters are ill with the same disease at their home. Frank J. Critcherson died Tuesday from influenza at his home in Eugene at the age of 55 years. Besides his wife, he is survived by his mother, Mrs. L. P. Glaze of Albany. The body will be forwarded to Albany for burial.

THREE IN COOS COUNTY

DEAD FROM INFLUENZA
Marsfield, Feb. 25.—Three deaths due to influenza or complications are reported in the county. Mrs. A. E. Adams, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. J. Crosby, died of pneumonia, following influenza. She was aged 20 and had been married only recently. Mrs. Pearl Smead died of influenza Tuesday at Coquille. She was formerly Miss Sydnor of Curry county and a sister of George Sydnor, who was shot and killed by George Chenoweth last spring. Mrs. A. Ford, for many years a resident of Bridge and mother of a large family, died at her home.

Medford Remains Open

Medford, Feb. 25.—"The flu situation here is not half as bad as had been represented," said Mayor C. E. Gates, after having made a two days' investigation. "and, therefore, I do not feel justified in closing or partially closing the city or prohibiting public gatherings of any kind, but will keep a close watch to see whether the physicians report all new cases. I find that many children are out of school, but their parents are keeping them out more because of fright over the prevalence of the flu than because of illness."

Bend Meeting Places Closed

Bend, Feb. 25.—As a precautionary measure against disease, Mayor J. A. Gates Tuesday issued a proclamation closing theatres, dance halls and skating rinks and asking that lodges cancel their meetings, that there be no private parties or gatherings and that people refrain from congregating in pool halls, stores and other places.

Nacozari, Mexico, Feb. 25.—(L. N. S.) Lieutenants G. L. Fisher and L. M. Wolf, members of the twelfth aero squadron, who made a forced landing 15 miles south of here February 2, were released from custody today by the Mexican military authorities, following receipt of an order from the foreign office at Mexico City.
