

Today's Market Basket

There is fish supply in plenty for everyone on this day. The markets are well stocked with fresh and frozen fish, but which is selling at slightly lower prices and there are unusually liberal stocks of Columbia river smelt selling at prices that are so far below the normal costs of food that the public has seemingly forgotten to save.
Columbia river smelt at 5 cents a pound is a food that cannot today be duplicated in any other line of food-stuffs.
The clam season has formally opened and today there are liberal stocks of "razors" available for the first time in many months. The opening of the season has caused liberal receipts of this sea food in the Portland market and consumers are being benefited not only by excellent quality, but lower prices.
Fresh salmon is not plentiful because of the closing of the season, but at the price there is sufficient for requirements.
Potatoes and onions are very high and

and consumers are advised to put some away in water-glass for winter use.
The following prices are averages and consumers are expected to pay retail prices. Quality noted in the average, fancy stuff being slightly higher and inferior stuff fractionally lower.
Eggs—Fresh laid, 47c per dozen; fancy fresh, 41c per dozen.
Butter—Best creamery prints, 72@77c lb. Cheese—Pammy, 40@45c per lb. Chicken—Dressed, 43@45c per lb.; game, dressed, 55c per lb.; turkeys, .60c lb.; ducks, 40c per lb.
Salmon—85c per lb.; Columbia smelt, 5c per lb.
Flour—Best local patent, \$2.45@2.50 per sack 49 lbs.
Potatoes—Barbanis, fancy, 7@8c per lb.; smelt, 10@12 1/2c per lb.
Onions—Dried, 6@7c per lb.

There is every indication that a still further advance will be made in values. Only scant stocks of onions remain unsold in the hands of farmers and these are commanding higher prices.
Potatoes are cheaper in Portland today than in any of the leading markets of the United States, although values are in reality very high. Oregon and Washington had a very short crop last season but despite this, potatoes are today selling here below what they are in the East where production was greater.
Fresh asparagus from California is in better supply with sales being made at lower prices.
Butter Market Lower
The drop of 3 cents a pound in the wholesale price of butter which went into effect Thursday is being made the basis of the new retail price by the dealers. There are indications of lower prices for the immediate future.
Eggs are getting down to what is expected to be the low price for the year.
