

KAPP'S FAILURE PLEASES LEADERS AT U. S. CAPITAL

Washington, March 16.—News of the collapse of Von Kapp's revolutionary government in Germany and the reascendancy of the Ebert regime was received with great satisfaction in every official quarter here tonight. So fast have events followed one another in Germany in the past two days that surprise over the failure of the militaristic coup d'état was at a minimum.

The opinion was held at the White House and at the state department that the attempt of Von Kapp to seize the reins of government in Germany would be abortive. It was argued that the suspicion that was in the minds of officials of the American government regarding the monarchical intentions of the Von Kapp adherents was just as deeply embedded in the minds of the great mass of German people and that therefore the movement would be resisted.

NEW TURKISH NOTE SENT

If Friedrich Ebert returns to Berlin and the last few sparks of the short lived rebellion are quickly extinguished, the main effect of the failure of the militaristic plot will be to strengthen immeasurably the Ebert government, according to officials here.

Great impetus will be given to his policies of peace, and things generally in Germany would assume a saner aspect than they have at any time since the signing of the armistice. The tension that now exists in every allied chancellery, and to a lesser degree also in the state department, will be relieved almost instantly.

The allies, it was pointed out, will be able to resume their program on the Asia Minor problem, and the United States and the allies will have a free hand in the formulation of the Turkish peace terms. It was reported today that the president had sent a communication to the council of premiers on the Turkish situation.

DON'T WANT NEW KAISER

Furthermore, the danger of a militaristic Germany will have been wholly dissipated and the proposal to resume commercial relations with the Russian federal soviet republic will pursue the even tenor of its way. This would have been an impossibility until the attitude of the Russian government toward the Von Kapp dictatorship was fully known.

Perhaps the greatest benefit that will emerge from the failure of the German reactionaries will be the total extinction of the belief or fear that Germany might strive to readopt the monarchical form of government.

The immediate consequences of the Ebert government was a call for a general strike, its sole means of retaliation against the war veterans who paved the way for the Von Kapp accession. It is taken by officials here to indicate a deep rooted aversion on the part of the common people of Germany to a return of "Kaiserism" in any form. This is the chief reason for the assumption that the Ebert government will be immensely strengthened.

COMMANDED BY ALLEN
Before news of the latest turn in the kaleidoscopic events of the past few days in Germany were received here tonight, the attention of officials was focused on that phase of the uprising that might involve the American forces on the Rhine. Some new and interesting facts came to light as a result.

It was definitely stated that Marshal Foch, the allied generalissimo, has no control of the American soldiers, who are under the command of Major General Henry T. Allen at Coblenz.

Whatever control he exercised was ended when France ratified the treaty of peace with Germany. At present the American forces are under the direct supervision of President Wilson.

While Major General Allen is reported

to be "sitting in" at the conference called at Mayence by General Foch, his presence is merely that of an observer, and should any decisive action be taken by the allies, General Allen would first have to communicate with Washington in order to receive explicit instructions from the president.

The official attitude was one of suspicion toward the men who fomented the revolution and formed the new government, chiefly because, it is believed, they represent the old reactionary element in Germany. The department of state was in direct communication with Berlin today, but only fragmentary dispatches were received and they only covered accounts which the newspapers have already published. The department was advised through official sources that a general strike was in force in Hamburg and that the city was under military control. The dispatch which was received this afternoon did not indicate the time of its filing, but it stated that there has been no disorders in Hamburg.

Wilson Given Copy Of Allies' Proposal

Washington, March 16.—(U. P.)—The allied decision on the Turkish question has been submitted by Ambassador Jusserand to the state department for the approval of President Wilson, it was indicated officially today.
