

ATTORNEY GENERAL WILL DECIDE VEXED IRRIGATION ISSUES

Bend, April 2. — A complete switch from the sides taken in 1916, when the settlers on the central Oregon irrigation project asked the state public service commission to take jurisdiction to prevent discrimination in the delivery of water, and to enforce proper maintenance, was made Thursday by attorneys for the district and the company, when the hearing before the commission on the application of the company for a maintenance fee of \$2.80 per acre was started.

No sooner had the case opened before Commissioners Fred A. Williams and H. H. Corey, than attorneys for the settlers introduced an objection to the taking of testimony, contending that that body has no jurisdiction. Counsel for the company argued against the objection with just as much interest, as they had taken the opposite side four years ago.

Upon reconvening the session in the afternoon the commission decided not to pass upon the matter of jurisdiction at this time, but to refer the point to Attorney-General Brown for decision.

Until a decision is handed down from the attorney-general's office the commission will take testimony in the case. In event it is determined upon the merits of the case, the testimony will be wiped out.

Mayor J. A. Easler has filed for county judge of Deschutes county on the Democratic ticket. Easler has served the city of Bend as mayor for two terms.

For the first time Thursday Bend was served by mail carriers, two carriers having been employed for this service. More than 900 stops are on the list.

Trees in Honor of La Grande Heroes Are to Line Road

La Grande, April 2. — The Woman's Neighborhood club has adopted a plan, presented by Mrs. Slater, of civic improvement, which will be linked up with a memorial to the achievements of the Union county boys in the service. Trees, probably maples, are to be planted on both sides of the street which leads from the city to Riverside park, beyond the city limits about a quarter of a mile. The street and road leading to the park is about a mile in length.

Hutchinson was a commissioner six years ago. He is connected with the First National bank at Union and is a member of one of the old pioneer families of Union county.

A petition for the nomination of J. W. Knowles on the Republican ticket for circuit judge in the Tenth judicial district is being circulated. Judge Knowles has held this office for 12 years. The Tenth district includes Union and Walla Walla counties.

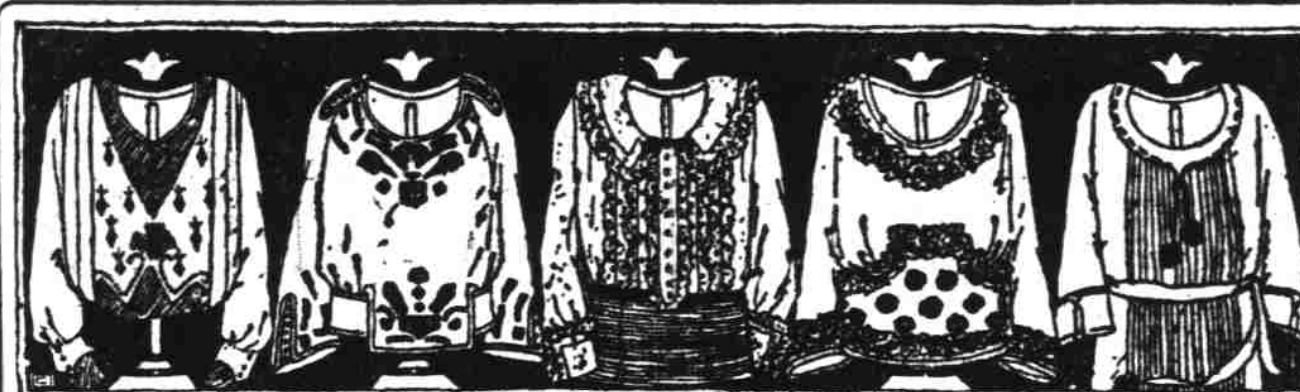

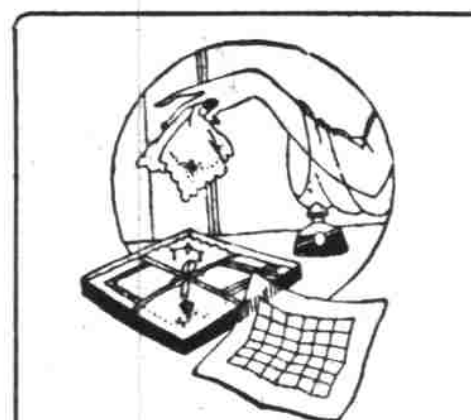
