

SEND DELEGATES UNINSTRUCTED, MADDOO'S ADVICE

New York, April 7.—(U. P.)—William G. Maddoo today outlined at the request of the United Press the reason for his recommendation that delegates to the Democratic national convention...

By William G. Maddoo. I do not object to primary elections for the selection of delegates to national conventions, but I think it is a mistake to send instructed delegates.

First. Only 17 states, I believe, authorize primaries. This leaves 31 states which choose their delegates by the old caucus method...

Second. The primaries are held at varying dates and under varying regulations in the different states, some of which do not properly safeguard the election.

Third. A two-thirds vote is required to nominate in a Democratic convention. So long as delegates are instructed, some by state primaries and others by state conventions...

Fourth. Political intrigue and political manipulation in a national convention are reduced to a minimum when the convention is composed of high-minded, clean-minded men and women who go there, not the blind champions of individual ambitions...

Fifth. Experience shows that only a small percentage of the people take part in state primaries for presidential candidates and that delegates are sometimes instructed by a pitiful minority of the voters of the state...

Sixth. The primary system of choosing presidential candidates might be ideal if practiced in the right way and made uniform in all states. It ought to be provided for and conducted under authority of federal law.

For instance, suppose that in every state a primary to choose presidential candidates was held in June of the presidential year, that the voters of each state could be aroused sufficiently to make them go to the polls and express their will...

So long as a nation-wide primary is not provided for, I am convinced that the national convention should be composed of uninstructed delegates, free to express their choice, and able to transact promptly the business of the convention...

BONUS QUESTION TO BE SETTLED BY CONVENTIONS

Washington, April 7.—(I. N. S.)—The question of a bonus for men who served in the military and naval forces during the world war will be settled at the national conventions. Leaders of both parties in congress today had agreed upon such a plan, and there will be no definite action on bonus legislation until after the conventions.

There is little likelihood of any cash bonus legislation during the present session of congress unless the national conventions direct it, leaders admit. In the bonus problem members of congress are facing one of the most delicate political questions they have to solve. Rejection of the bonus legislation might incur the disfavor of the "soldier vote."
