

INJUNCTION SUIT EXPECTED OVER ROGUE FISHING

Injunction proceedings will follow the fish and game commission's attempt to embody in its rules the Macleay-Medford-Ashland agreement affecting Rogue river fishing, announced Wilford Allen of Grants Pass, president of the Josephine Sportsmen's league, when he came to Portland Thursday.

The fish and game commission has been expected to act on the agreement at its meeting next Monday. E. V. Carter, chairman of the commission, in an address at Medford, endorsed the plan.

"Thus," said Allen, "Carter, who was appointed as referee of the commission, put himself in the position of the judge who decides a case before he hears the evidence."

"The agreement with Macleay was made in secret. Not more than half a dozen people in Medford knew about it. It confines commercial fishing to the last 12 miles of the Rogue, but this is entirely through Macleay's property. He owns every foot on both sides of the stream. There is only one way of reaching it—a country road leads to Gold Beach. The agreement permits Macleay to maintain his drift nets, but it eliminates the small amount of drift net fishing at Grants Pass. It lessens Macleay's season. We will not accept any agreement which discriminates against the commercial fishing at Grants Pass. We will persist in an effort to place on the baiting measure entirely eliminating commercial fishing on the Rogue river."

Dr. Arthur K. Downs, president of the Oregon Sportsmen's league, called attention to the fact that, although the name of S. C. Bartrum appears on the agreement as secretary of the Oregon Sportsmen's league, the league itself at its last annual meeting went on record as opposed to the continuance of any commercial fishing on Rogue river. "Bartrum has attempted to controvert the position of the state organization and he should resign as secretary at once," declared Dr. Downs.

Power Rates Rise Fought; Bi-State Conference Is Held

Ontario, Or., April 8.—Commissioners Corey and Williams of the Oregon public service commission, and Commissioner Erb and Engineer Gordon of the Idaho utilities commission, held a conference here Thursday afternoon and evening with representatives of the Idaho Power company and officers of irrigation projects in regard to an advance in power rates. The company has applied for permission to raise its charges 30 per cent for power furnished for irrigation purposes.

As there are 45,000 acres of land in Malheur country along the Snake river that is irrigated by power pumps, it is a matter of vital interest to the landowners. Many of the farmers consider the present charge all the land will carry and are putting up a hard fight against the increase.

Jersey Jubilee at Salem Promises to Be Classy Affair

Salem, April 8.—Salem will be host to Jersey breeders attending the second annual Oregon Jersey Jubilee, May 3 to 6, at a banquet to be served here the night of May 6, according to plans under way here. Some of the foremost Jersey breeders of the nation are expected to attend the jubilee this year.

Many prominent Sunday school and church workers from all over Oregon are on the program of the Marion County Sunday School association, which assembled here today in annual session. Representative delegations from the eight districts of the county are present at the session, which will continue throughout Saturday.

Mill Creek Power Sold for \$100,000 To Paper Company

Salem, April 8.—Transfer of all the "north power" on Mill creek here from the Salem Flouring Mills to the Oregon Pulp & Paper company for use in the operation of its plant now in the course of construction, is said to be involved in a deal pending between the two interests, which is said to involve a consideration of \$100,000. A total of 15 acres of land adjoining the three power sites in the "north power" units is said to be included in the proposed transfer. The power sites are of sufficient capacity to develop approximately 2700 horsepower to which another 1000 horsepower will be added through the erection of a power plant at a cost of approximately \$50,000.
