

## PROSECUTION IN THE TOMBSTONE CASES NEARS COMPLETION

Tombstone, Ariz., April 22.—(U. P.)—Indications today were that the prosecution in the Bisbee deportations trial was nearing the end of its present line of evidence, which covers the story of the deportations of miners from the Warren district in 1917.

County Prosecutor French expects to inject new phases into the case during today's testimony, he said.

The recital of alleged cruelties to deported miners and their families continued throughout yesterday.

Nestor Sjofeld, miner, told a pathetic story, claiming that he had started from his home to call a doctor for his 3-month-old baby when he was stopped by two armed men. The men entered his house and when his wife protested they knocked her down twice, he said. They threw the baby across the bed and ordered him out of the house.

"When I left my wife was lying on the floor with blood running from her mouth and nose," he declared.

Sjofeld also said he saw two men shot. He could not give their names, but said one was a striker and the other he described as a "gunman." Both were left dead on the ground near his house, he said. These were the only fatalities of the deportations.

## Signalling to Mars Dubbed as Foolish By Geneva Observer

Chicago, April 22.—Professor Edwin B. Frost of the Lake Geneva observatory, a noted astronomical authority, made light of Professor David Todd's attempts to signal to Mars.

"I must necessarily deprecate the publication of such sensational reports," said Professor Frost. "The possibilities of communicating with Mars are so utterly nil that one is filled with awe and admiration for the imagination that conceived the idea."

"Think of the earth's orbit as a circle around the sun. Then that of Mars would be drawn as an elongated ellipse outside the circle."

"It would necessarily be nearer the earth at some points than at others, but at no point would it be nearer than 35,000,000 miles, and at the other extreme about 250,000,000 miles from the earth."

"It will, therefore, be clear to any intelligent person that nothing is to be gained by ascending four or five miles in a balloon. It would be easier to wait until August, 1924, when Mars will be 20,000,000 miles closer than it is now."
