

ODD FELLOWSHIP RALLIES TO OBSERVE FOUNDING EVENT

Portland Odd Fellowship celebrated the hundred and first anniversary of the founding of the order in America at a great mass meeting in The Auditorium Monday night. The two Portland encampments, the 16 subordinate lodges, with the auxiliary Rebekah organizations, participated, the program being patriotic, fraternal, musical and social.

The 3000 people attending were not all Odd Fellows, as the invitation had been extended to the public.

Past Grand Master M. C. George and Dr. A. H. Johnson, deputy grand master, delivered the principal addresses, discussing the principles of the order and the needs of America for truer concepts of its destiny.

Dr. Johnson, who was chairman of the evening, paid high tribute to the women of the Rebekah organizations.

One feature was a flag presentation by Canton Portland No. 1, Patriarchs Militant. Another was the drill by Star lodge, which has lately admitted a large number of Portland policemen. The police executed intricate marching maneuvers.

The Rebekah lodges also staged a dainty drill. Dancing followed until midnight.

The musical program included: Overture, I. O. O. F. band; cornet duet, Thelma Stephens and G. G. Rapenney; violin solo, Miss Helen Harper, with Miss Jean Harper as accompanist; vocal solos by Mrs. A. W. Claxon, with Mrs. Edith Stiles Miller as accompanist, ending with a grand medley by the Odd Fellows band.

The celebration was one of many held throughout the country.

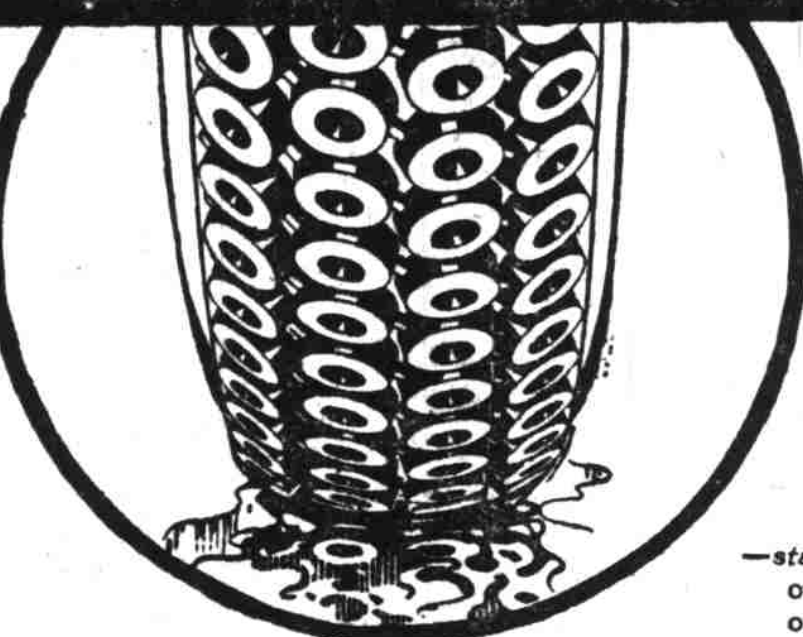
