SPARROWS RECEIPTS INCREASE

Very liberal increase of sparrows from Columbia river ports is shown and the movement at the moment is causing prices to rise. Sales along the coast were made at \$2.20 to \$2.10 per dozen for long grain.

Low Angeles strawberries were again reported in the local market and there were fairly liberal offerings from the Fern section. Demand is reported as fair.

POTATO DEMAND GROWING FAST

Demand for potatoes is growing fast here. The local market, with the arrival of a carload during the day was an aid. Prices were somewhat firmer all around and especially on the favored sizes.

CHICKEN PRICES ARE LOWERED

Further weakness was displayed in the chicken market for the day and some sales of light weight hens were shown as low as 30c a pound, with heavy at 32c, although most of the dealers were asking more.
