

SHRINE PROGRAM TO INCLUDE FOUR STREET PARADES

The program for Shrine week will be announced shortly, says the general committee for the 1920 convention. Included will be four great parades, two to be given by the bands and patrols of the various temples and two to be put on by the city of Portland.

The first parade will be the daylight escort from the Multnomah hotel to the Auditorium for the Imperial council, in which all the uniformed bodies will be in line. This is set for 9 o'clock Tuesday morning, June 22.

ELECTRIC PARADE PLANNED
Tuesday night Portland will put on the famous electric parade. This is one of the big features of the great Rose Festival and will consist this year of close to a score of electrically decorated and flower-bedecked operated cars. Each will tell its story, which this year will be an Oriental legend.

On the night of June 23, starting at 8 o'clock, will come the night Shrine parade.
On the afternoon of June 24, at 3 o'clock, is the opening of the Rose Festival proper, with twice as many decorated automobiles and horse-drawn carriages as in any previous year, all hidden by roses. Many unique designs are under way for this great occasion of the week.

FESTIVAL CENTER FEATURE
A total of \$35,000 will be spent on the creation of a Festival Center this year, by which three park blocks near the Arlington club will be converted into an Oriental garden of roses.
C. R. Grism, United States inspector, was named captain at large of the Shrine hospitality committee Monday by A. L. Tetu, chairman. Grism will have headquarters at the Imperial hotel. Tetu will announce other aides in the near future.
Mrs. A. H. Lea, wife of the Imperial potentate of Al Kader temple, the wives of all past potentates, Mrs. F. S. Grant and Mrs. Tetu will serve as a woman's auxiliary to the main committee.

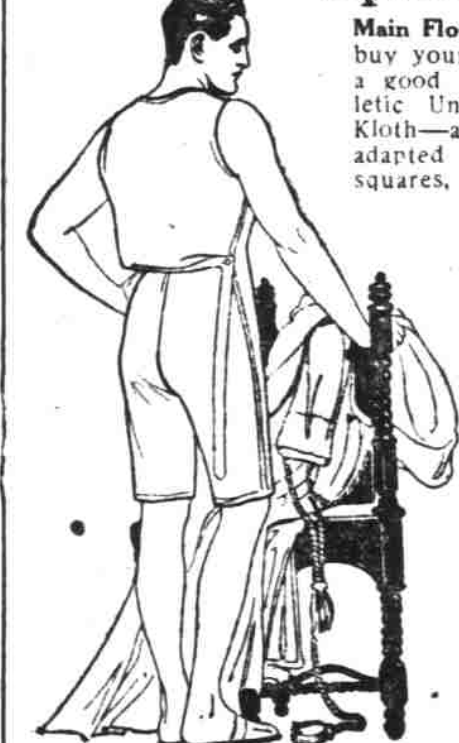
